5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

Due to failure of the existing brick veneer on a portion of the south side of the building, the existing brick has been removed for safety concerns. The area affected is on the south side of the building. This area is approximately 20' wide and 30' high and is a gable. Because the same brick is no longer available, we would like to use a stone veneer blend typical of the original period at which this property was built. Many of the buildings in this area have a combination of stone and brick on them, including this building. If the stone is not acceptable, we have several brick samples, which is as close a match as we can possibly find. Ultimately, we are hoping to use stone, however, if this does not meet your renovation criteria, we would like you to choose from one of the samples we provide. There is also a failing concrete stoop, at the same area, which we will need to remove and install new concrete. This is the main entry to the two units at the property.
