There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. ## Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

REPEAT OBSERVATION: There is no Person in Charge and the employees do not have knowledge on cross contamination, temperatures of food or equipment, thermometer calibration, pests, and safe chemicals use/storage Corrective Action(s): Obtain a Person in Charge or CFM and have them provide training in critical areas. Inspector will do training with the 2 employees who are running the store. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 2-401.11 (A) - EATING, DRINKING, OR USING TOBACCO

This is a core item

Observation: (CORRECTED DURING INSPECTION): Cigarette butts observed in the grease filter.

Corrective Action(s): Provide employee break room or designate an area away from food preparation for eating and

tobacco use. Action Taken: Discarded. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 3-101.11 - SAFE UNADULTERATED AND HONESTLY PRESENTED

This is a priority item

Observation: (CORRECTED DURING INSPECTION): Old spoiled fish was observed in the prep cooler.

Corrective Action(s): Discard unsafe or adulterated food Items. Action Taken: Discarded, Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 3-302.11 (A) (1) - PACKAGED AND UNPACKAGED FOOD - RAW OVER RTE-FOODS

This is a priority item

Observation: Since the walk in cooler is down, all the raw meat was packed into the prep cooler next to cooked gyro meat and produce.

Corrective Action(s): Reorganize storage so that ready-to-eat foods are stored above raw animal food and raw vegetables. Discard ready-to-eat foods that show evidence of contamination. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

## 3-304.14 (B) (1) - WIPING CLOTHS - USE LIMITATION - CLOTHS FOR WIPING COUNTERS STORED IN SANITIZER This is a core item

Observation: There were wet and soiled towels on the cutting board and counters.

Corrective Action(s): Cloths used for wiping counters shall be stored in a sanitizing solution. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

### 3-305.11 (A) (2) - FOOD CONTAMINATION PREVENTED FROM PREMISE - NOT EXPOSED TO SPLASH AND DUST This is a core item

Observation: 1. The entire store including kitchen area is covered in a sticky dust from construction. 2. Single service trays in back have been leaked on by the ceiling. 3. Foam containers, cardboard boats and aluminum pans have been contaminated by splashed cheese and dirty towels. 4. The hood filters are dripping grease over the grill. Corrective Action(s): 1. Clean all the shelves, equipment and surfaces free from dusty grime.

2. Discard wet drink travs.

- 3. Discard aluminum pans, boats and foam containers that have been contaminated.
- 4. Clean the hood filters. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 3-305.11 (A) (3) - FOOD CONTAMINATION PREVENTED FROM PREMISE - OFF THE FLOOR

This is a core item

Observation: A bag of onions was on the floor of the kitchen.

Corrective Action(s): Store all food items 6 inches above the floor. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 3-401.14 (F) - NON-CONTINUOUS COOKING OF RAW ANIMAL FOODS - WRITTEN PLAN

This is a priority foundation item

Observation: The gyro cone was partially cooked and then refrozen. The non-continuous cook process has no prior approval or the approved plan is not being followed.

Corrective Action(s): Food improperly prepared shall be discarded. Submit plan for approval by regulatory authority and once approved shall be followed by management and employees. You may either submit a plan to refreeze it or cook the entire cone. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 3-501.16 (A) (2) AND (B) - PHF/TCS, COLD HOLDING

This is a priority item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: 1. Pudding and cheesecakes in the front display cooler were 49F.

- 2. Prep cooler lettuce 67, corned beef 57, tziki sauce 58, raw chicken 58, gyro meat 45.3 and pooling water in the top and bottom.
- 3. The walk in cooler is down and has parts on order.

Corrective Action(s): Maintain cold potentially hazardous foods at or below 41°F.

Repair all coolers and remove standing water from the prep cooler top and bottom. See Suspension order. Foods were discarded. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 3-501.17 - RTE/PHF-TCS PROPER DATE MARKING

This is a priority foundation item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: Corned beef and gyro meat were not datemarked.

Corrective Action(s): Adjust method or procedures so that all ready-to-eat potentially hazardous foods (time/temperature control for safety food), if required, are provided with date marking or an effective method of identifying when a food item has exceeded 7-days. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 4-202.11 (1) - (4) - EQUIPMENT AND UTENSILS - FOOD CONTACT SURFACES, CLEANABILITY

This is a priority foundation item

Observation: The cutting board on the prep table is burnt, stained and grooved. Corrective Action(s): Replace cutting board on prep table. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

### 4-204.112 (B) - THERMOMETERS - FUNCTIONALITY - INTEGRAL OR PERMANENTLY AFFIXED MEASURING DEVICE

This is a core item

Observation: There is no thermometer for the display cooler, walk in cooler or the prep cooler with an integral or permanently affixed temperature measuring device.

Corrective Action(s): Equipment used for hot and cold holding shall be designed to include and shall be equipped with at least one integral or permanently affixed temperature measuring device. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 4-302.12 (A) - FOOD TEMPERATURE MEASURING DEVICES - PROVIDED

This is a priority foundation item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: No thermometer is present for monitoring temperatures in foods.

Corrective Action(s): Provide thermometers that are easily accessible and capable of taking temperatures in food and know how to calibrate them. Inspector will do training on this with you. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 4-601.11 (C) - NON-FOOD CONTACT SURFACES - CLEAN

This is a core item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: 1. Clean all the equipment at the cookline to include walls, pipes, shelves, fryers, freezer exterior/interior/door gasket and top, tables, and carts free from grease and food debris.

- 2. Rails of the display cooler contain dirt and dead insects. Clean rails.
- 3. The wall by the door has water stains running down it. Clean walls.
- 4. The mop sink contains a layer of gray slime. Clean mop sink.
- 5. The upright freezer contains blood on the inside and the exterior of the freezer is greasy and grimey. Clean upright freezer.
- 6. The wall to floor juction and door frames in the entire establishment have an accumulation of black grime. Do a detailed cleaning of the basecoved area in the store to include door frames and all corners.
- 7. Greasy cardboard present on carts and shelving units. Remove greasy cardboard.
- 8. There is a white greasy bucket to hold the french fry pan that is not cleanable and grease is pooling is the lip and grooves of the bucket. Remove bucket and replace it with something cleanable.
- 9. The interior of the microwave is soiled and there is food debris in the unused steam jackets. Clean microwave and steamer unit.

Corrective Action(s): Clean and remove dust, dirt, food residue, and other debris from all non-food contact surfaces of equipment. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 5-205.11 - USING A HANDWASHING SINK - ACCESSIBLE

This is a priority foundation item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: Handwashing sink observed to be blocked by a large tub of bleach towels during inspection and is unavailable for proper handwashing.

Corrective Action(s): Keep handwashing sink free of obstructions and in working condition at all times to allow for frequent handwashing. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 5-205,15 (B) - PLUMBING - SYSTEM MAINTAINED IN GOOD REPAIR

This is a core item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: 1. The prep sink drain receptor is broken loose rendering the prep sink unusable for prepping raw chicken and fish.

- 2. The spray head of the warewashing arm is broken and sprays water out.
- 3. The faucet does not reach the sanitizer sink.

Corrective Action(s): The plumbing system shall be maintained in good repair. Repair or replace defective or leaking plumbing. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 6-202.15 (A) (1) - INSECTS AND RODENTS - OUTER OPENINGS PROTECTED

This is a core item

Observation: There is a gap at the rear door which could allow the entrance of insects or rodents,

Corrective Action(s): Repair this hole or gap so that entrance by insects or rodents into the food establishment is

prevented. Keep the back door closed at all time. Install a screen door if you want fresh air in the building. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 6-301.11 - HANDWASHING CLEANSER AVAILABILITY

This is a priority foundation item

Observation: Soap not available at food employee handwashing sink in the bathroom.

Corrective Action(s): Provide hand soap at handwashing sink to facilitate proper handwashing. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 6-301.12 - HAND DRYING PROVISION

This is a priority foundation item

Observation: No single-use toweling or other hand drying device available at handwashing sink for hand drying in the bathroom or the kitchen handsink.

Corrective Action(s): Provide single-use toweling or other approved devices at handwashing sink to facilitate proper handwashing. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 6-501.11 - REPAIRING - PREMISES, STRUCTURES, ATTACHMENTS, AND FIXTURES - METHODS

This is a core item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: DO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Clean or replace dirty or broken light shields.
- 2. Replace missing or damaged ceiling tiles. Replace the acoustic tiles in the kitchen with cleanable and durable ceiling tiles. There is now tape holding the tiles to the framework, if at anytime the tapes starts to peel off the ceiling will have to be repaired to code.
- 3. Paint or seal all the bare wood of the new glass enclosure.
- 4. Remove the greasy bare wood board under the safe.
- 5. Repair the floor tiles where the new display cooler was added at the service counter.
- 6. Repair the falling wire shelf by the door entry.
- 7. Replace the missing basecove behind the walk in cooler and anywhere else it is missing.
- 8. The concrete cinder blocks under the hood are peeling and pitted and no longer up to code. Install stainless steel or tile on the wall under the hood.
- 9. The prep cooler lid is broken. Repair or replace prep cooler lid.

Corrective Action(s): Premises must remain in good repair. Repair all broken and damaged fixtures. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 6-501,111 (B) - CONTROLLING PESTS - INSPECTING PREMISE

This is a core item

REPEAT OBSERVATION: 1. Mouse droppings along all walls of the entire establishment, on food shelves, and inside the display case and under the beverage cooler.

2. Fruit and house flies present in the kitchen and bathroom area.

Corrective Action(s): Rountinely inspect facilities for insects and rodents. See Suspension order. Clean up droppings and treat for flies. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### 6-501.114 - MAINTAINING PREMISES, UNNECESSARY ITEMS AND LITTER

This is a core item

Observation: The enclosed cage area off the rear door has debris, garbage and items not necessary for the operation. Inside, remove all wet and damaged items from the ceiling leaks.

Corrective Action(s): Items that are unnecessary to the operation of the food establishment shall be removed from the premise. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

## 7-102.11 - TOXIC SUBSTANCES - IDENTIFYING INFORMATION, PROMINENCE - COMMON NAME-WORKING CONTAINER

This is a priority foundation item

Observation: Unlabelled chemical bottle present and staff was unsure what it was.

Corrective Action(s): Label working containers of all chemicals. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 7-202.11 - TOXIC SUBSTANCES - RESTRICTION - PRESENCE AND USE

This is a priority foundation item

Observation: Raid bug spray is being used for fruit flies and is not approved for use in food areas.

Corrective Action(s): Remove unapproved toxic chemicals from premise. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 7-207.11 (A) - TOXIC SUBSTANCES - MEDICINE - RESTRICTION

Page #4 of #5

This is a priority foundation item

Observation: *(CORRECTED DURING INSPECTION):* Cold medicines and antibiotic were located in kitchen. Corrective Action(s): Remove all medicine not necessary for employee health. Action Taken: Items removed. Correct By: 04-Oct-2018

#### 8-201.16 - PUBLIC RESTROOMS - GOOD REPAIR AND SUPPLIED WITH TOILET TISSUE

This is a core item

Observation: The bathroom is in disrepair. Ceiling is leaking with missing panels. Toilet tank lid is missing. No handle to flush the toilet. There is foam sealant around the toilet and walls that is degrading and is accumulating mold, water and grime where fruit flies are breeding.

Corrective Action(s): Repair ceiling. Replace missing toilet tank lid. Replace flushing handle. Remove all foam sealant, clean bathroom, provide proper basecoving and caulk the base of the toilet. Correct By: 18-Oct-2018

#### Comments:

NOTE: Ceiling tiles are now taped and painted to the ceiling frames. This will need to be removed and repaired properly if the tape ever starts to peel off.

An Order to Cease Operations has been issued, see separate report.

As a result of the amount of violations and your final score for the grading system, suspend all processing or potentially hazardous food sales

Establishment needs to contact Inspector prior to reopening.



Good Morning Ald. Coggs,

I'm writing again to complain about my liquor store neighbor at 3500 N. Port Washington Ave. and want to add to that a complaint about my Neighborhood Services inspector, Mr. Bates, who seems to acting on their behalf and aiding them in retaliation towards me for my complaints about their persistent litter that I pick up everyday and their clients urinating on my property and doing drugs in front on the gallery windows for me and my patrons to see. Please Note: I have all of this recorded on photographically and on video. Both the liquor store owners and inspector have use racist and/or racially toned and flippant language towards black people and this community and they're both intolerable. Mr. Bates cited me for construction debris notice yesterday while my business was closed for my wood, lined up along "my" back fence, on "my" property as my building is still under construction and the materials are and will still be used to complete the project. Further, the materials will be used in an art project as I work on wood from my construction projects as an attempt to reduce waste. I only found the notice because I was doing my annoying daily litter pick up and the notice was blowing on the ground and was caught in the corner or my side door entrance, again contributing to the litter problem. It is a fact that my project is still under construction as the commercial kitchen and other items are still being remedied and I'm working tirelessly to complete everything. I had three technicians here yesterday. When I told Inspector Bates that my wood is still in use as I'm still under construction, his reply was "Well I just don't believe you and you need to think about that when you're going around complaining about trash in your neighbors' yard." I called his supervisor, Christine Reed, and left her a message. I am writing you as neighborly discussions has not worked and me exercising my right and concern as a resident and business owner by calling my inspector has shown me I have no agency for ridding my property and neighborhood from this problem, which is an unnecessary and controllable issue. The liquor store and the inspector's attitude of "Well this is YOUR people" and "that's just what y'all do in these neighborhoods" and backing it up with the violence and criminal activity they associate with this neighborhood

will not suffice. When I argue that there are clean liquor stores and that this wouldn't occur nor be tolerated in the suburbs, the inspector just speaks over me. When will the liquor start being fined \$500 per occurrence for their contribution? It's a nuisance. When will I have protection over my grievance?

FYI: I am not throwing out my materials until my project is complete. If they send people to remove the items of my personal property, they will have to compensate me to replace them. I have photographs and inventory of my whole property.

On 02-22-19 at 10:25 p.m., we responded to District 5 to meet Sq. 5286 (PO VALUCH and PO KAMPS). Upon arrival we were also met by John ALTENHOFEN, a State of Wisconsin Department of Revenue Agent, in the department of Field Compliance, Income, Sales and Excise Tax Division.

Upon meeting with ALTENHOFEN he informed us that he was attempting to contact the agent of Lux Bar., located at 2712 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr., which is a licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee. He stated that the agent, Thomas HOLMES II (b/m 05-18-84) was to have a meeting with the state regarding his business, which he did not attend. The state also attempted to speak to HOLMES over the telephone -regarding the hearing, but HOLMES refused to listen, telling ALTENHOFEN he was harassing him and hung up the telephone, while on the telephone with HOLMES, ALTENHOFEN was informed that he was in Miami and not in Milwaukee. ALTENHOFEN was asking us to accompany him to the tavern, so that the tavern could be served official paper work.

We went to the bar and upon walking up to the bar, we observed the door man (bouncer) standing in front of the front glass door, so as we could not see inside of the bar. Our body worn cameras were activated at this time, prior to entering the tavern.

Upon walking up to the front door, PO MACRAE was met by the bouncer (doorman), Gary R. SMITH (Jr) (b/m 6-18-82), who stated he works the front door, checking ID's and patting people down for weapons. He stated that he only works the front door and does nothing else with the interior of the bar. While speaking to SMITH, we then spoke to a representative of the bar, Nathan D. FRACTION (b/m 10-06-81), who stated he is assisting HOLMES with the bar, managing the bar when HOLMES is not at the business. He stated the owner (HOLMES) was not at the bar and did not know where he was at this time.

I walked into the bar and observed a female walking from behind the bar and towards the front door. I stopped her and asked her if she was the bartender, to which she stated she was. I continued to speak to the bartender, Latonia L. GUIDER (b/f 06-21-66), who has a valid Class D Bartenders License (0229328). GUIDER stated she is the normal bartender during the weeks, with the exception of Mondays. I informed her that I was here to check the licenses of the bar, as well as ALTENHOFEN needing to speak to her.

ALTENHOFEN informed GUIDEN that he was there because he needed to serve the bar with a notice of

revocation on Thomas HOLMES II, who is 100% owner (shareholder) of the bars LLC. He informed her that the notice if from a trust tax hearing that HOLMES missed in Madison. He informed GUIDEN that she could or could not sign the form, but that she needed to give HOLMES the notice and inform him that HOLMES needed to comply by March 14th, 2019 and if he did not the state of Wisconsin would come to the establishment and close the bar. This interaction between ALTENHOFEN and GUIDEN was captured on my body worn camera.

As the GUIDEN, ALTENHOFEN and I were conversing, PO KAMPS, PO VALUCH and PO MACRAE conducted a check of the first floor area of the bar, according to the license. While checking the first floor, officers KAMPS and VALUCH observed entered the men's restroom and observed visible cleaner inside of the toilet bowl, with a bottle of cleaner in a garbage can in the bathroom. There was no cleaner in the upper water tank of the toilet. Officer's KAMPS and VALUCH stated that they believed that prior to our arrival at the bar, some sort of substance was dumped into the toilet. PO VALUCH went into more detail about the cleaner and stated the upper toilet tank water was clear, while the water in the toilet bowl was a blue/purple color, with a strong fresh odor.

It should be noted, that upon our arrival FRACTION was observed walking towards us from the area where the bathrooms are located.

Based on what was happening at the bar, with the State delivering papers, along with what was observed in the bathroom of the bar, PO MACRAE informed SMITH that HOLMES contact us regarding our visit. At the time of this report, HOLMES has not contacted us.

The tavern does have a valid Class B Tavern license (0205609) and expires 11-22-19.

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This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to the District 5 Tavern Squad (5468), with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 03-19-19 at 10:05 p.m., we met with John ALTENHOFEN for the Wisconsin State Department of Revenue, in order to issue the final notice from the State to the bar, indicating that the agent of the bar, Thomas J. HOLMES (b/m 05/18/84) had not satisfied the tax situation and sellers permit issues with the State and to stop selling taxable items. If the bar continued to sell taxable items, the bar could face criminal charges.

It should be noted the final day to correct the problems was March 14th, 2019 and the bar was observed open on March 16th and 17th by officers driving by the bar.

We eventually went to the bar and observed the bar open for business, with Austrilia C. PORTIS (b/f 05-27-92) bartending and Nathan A. FRACTION (b/m 10-06-81) the business partner of the agent HOLMES, managing the bar. ALTENHOFEN and I began to speak to PORTIS, who has a valid Class D Operator's license (0228309). ALTENHOFEN explained the bar could not be open due to having no State Sellers Permit and that HOLMES had not satisfied his obligations with the State regarding his sellers permit. PORTIS stated she believed FRACTION to be the owner of the bar and when I mentioned HOLMES name, she did not know who that was. PORTIS stated she was not comfortable in speaking to ALTENHOFEN and that we should speak to FRACTION regarding this incident.

ALTENHOFEN explained the situation to FRACTION, who attempted to contact HOLMES, but could not reach him. A copy of the paperwork was given to FRACTION and he was informed that if the State was informed that the bar was open after today, the bar could face criminal charges. I asked FRACTION if he would voluntarily close the bar, now having the paperwork from the state and he stated he did not want any problems and would voluntarily close the bar until the the situation was resolved.

I have attached copies of the paperwork from the state to this report.


