Your Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises License Renewal Applications with Change of Agent as agent for "Mojo MKE LLC" for "Mojo MKE" at 134 E JUNEAU Av.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of bllowing reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings during normal business hours is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of Kilbourn Avenue and Water Street. You must present a copy of the meeting notice to the parking cashier.

 On 02/26/21 at 8:07p, officers conducted a License Premise Check at Mojo MKE, 134 E. Juneau Av. The agent was on scene and no violations were found. 					
2. On 08/16/21 at 12:27am, officers observed a fight in the street outside of Mojo MKE, 134 E.					

Juneau Av. Investigation revealed a patron was being removed from the bar, at which time he attempted to punch the security manager. The security manager then pushed the patron to the ground and kicked the patron in the shoulder. Medical attention was refused by both parties. The security manager was advised regarding professionalism and proper use of force in removing

3. On 06/25/22 at 12:15am, Milwaukee Police observed a security guard from 134 E. Juneau Avenue physically assault a homeless person in front of the tavern. While taking the security guard into custody for the assault, another security guard removed a holstered pistol from the assault suspect and handed it to another person, who then disappeared into the crowd of patrons. After placing the subject into handcuffs, police asked security for the gun and they originally stated that "his guy" was going take the gun, then stated to officers that there was no gun.

- 4. On 07/09/22 at 10:54pm, a Milwaukee Police officer was instructed by a supervisor to inform the tavern at 134 E. Juneau Avenue that it was playing their music to loud. The officer found the front door to the establishment to be locked and told the manager to lower the music and unlock the front door. The manager said he would lower the music and unlock the front door. He explained to police that the front door was locked because he did not want to put another "door man" on the front entrance because most of his business was on the patio. Later in the evening (2:03am), police observed a large fight in the patio area of the tavern. It took approximately 15 officers to break up the physical fight. The manager, who was unaware of the large fight, was told that there has been an "uptick" in problems at the establishment with patrons and employees. He stated that he wanted to cooperate and would try to find a solution to the problems.
- 5. On 07/13/22 at 8:16pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 134 E. Juneau Avenue. Police informed the manager that they could only have 49 patrons on the patio and they needed to lower the volume of the music. No violations were observed and all individuals on scene were cooperative.

6. On 06/05/23 at 1:02a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 134 E. Juneau. The officers observed and discussed the following violations at the establishment, to which the manager was cooperative and stated they would correct and develop a plan moving forward to alleviate any problems:

- Over capacity on the Outdoor Patio
- Music could be heard 100 ft from the Sidewalk
- Parking on City Sidewalk
- 7. On 10/12/23 at 8:34p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted an Underage Compliance Check at 134 E. Juneau. A 20-year-old Police Aide entered the bar and was asked to provide ID, however, was still allowed entry when they stated they left their ID at home. The underage Police Aide was able to purchase a Whiteclaw from the bartender. The bartender left prior to officers having the opportunity to conduct an interview with them. The officers advised the manager on duty of the violations and they stated they would be speaking to security regarding the issue.

To whom it may concern:

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 1/23/2024 at 10:00 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
