Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. 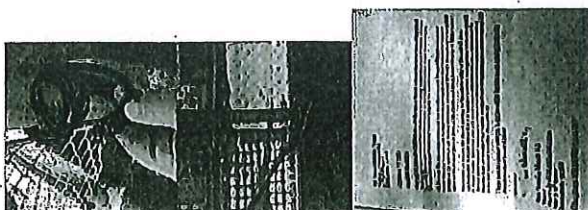

All,

If a tavern is using your parking lot and you are sure that it is the staff of Snifters parking vehicles in your lot without your consent then there are a few things we can do.

1. We could sit down with the licensee and have a formal conversation that is documented for licensing purposes, spelling out that the business cannot use your lot.
2. If #1 doesn't work. You could enter into a business agreement with a private towing company to monitor and remove vehicles not associated with the church. Signage would have to be posted at the lot.
3. Because your parking lot is private property MPD/DPW parking enforcement will not monitor solely for parking issues.

broken glass in the gutter on all four corners of 4th and Bruce Streets. (photos)

Concerning the glass in the alleyway, according to police officer Jesús Rodríguez whom I met in the alleyway, one or more of the night clubs on 5th Street has been using our lot for valet parking on Friday and Saturday nights without permission to do so. Moreover, according to Officer Rodríguez, the incident in the wee hours of the night involved the theft of firearms. That was really the tipping point.

What can we do to curb the violence against property (and persons)? How can law enforcement, and the night clubs work together?

The alleyway has installed a lamp on the north side that illuminates about halfway down Bruce. (photo). We would also be willing to install another one on the northwest corner.

I am sure that

we would be willing to install a lamp

Additionally, we have placed a padlock on the door and closing it off

on the weekends.

As for Snifter's, what is their ownership willing to do? It can't be good for business that cars are being broken into every weekend, and it certainly is not good for community relations that they've been using the alleyway without permission and that we have to clean up the messes that, I am sure, would not be there but for the nighttime activity.

I would ask that you act as a go-between, especially with Snifter's, in seeking solutions to this disheartening problem.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

4. On 03/14/19 at 5:15pm, Milwaukee Police, along with an agent from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue conducted a license premise check of 606-610 S. 5th Street. Upon entering the establishment, officers observed an illuminated "Open" sign in the window and no patrons inside. Investigation revealed that the sole bartender in the establishment did not have a Class D license, the Wisconsin sellers permit was not posted, a quantity of liquor was purchased from an unauthorized seller, empty bottles were not being defaced, the premise was refilling liquor bottles, all of the invoices for liquor purchases were not kept on premise for two years, and eight bottles were found to be contaminated with fruit flies. A citation was mailed to the applicant for Responsible Person on Premise Required.

5. On 08/08/20 at 12:40am officers were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at Snifters, 606 S. 5th St. Officers were advised by the agent they removed an unruly patron from the bar and believed the patron shot a firearm outside of the bar. Officers did not locate any casings and there was no video of the incident. The agent was cooperative with the investigation.
 6. On 09/13/20 at 2:20am, officers responded to Snifters, 606 S. 5th for a gun shot victim. Officers were met by the victim who stated he was on the corner of 5th and Bruce having a cigarette after bar close, when a vehicle drove by and began shooting in his direction. The victim stated he was at Snifters bar earlier, however, he did not have an altercation with anyone and did not know why he was shot at. Management was cooperative with police and stated they did have video surveillance inside the bar.
 7. On 01/29/21 at 10:38pm, officers conducted a license premise check at Snifters, 606 S. 5th St. No violations were found and employees were cooperative with police.

8. On 12/19/21 at 2:15am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 606 S. 5th Street for a fight complaint. Investigation revealed that a fight occurred inside the tavern with approximately 30 patrons. Security pushed the physical fight outside and went back into the tavern leaving the approximately 30 patrons to continue physically fighting. Police had to dispense Oleoresin Capsicum to stop the fight and one officer was assaulted during the incident outside. The applicant was asked what the capacity was for the establishment and he told officers that it was 168 (City of Milwaukee license search revealed that the capacity is 99). Officers did observe several patrons inside the tavern after closing with open intoxicants and the applicant was told several times that all patrons must be out by 2:30am. The applicant was unable to operate his surveillance footage so officers could review what happen during the incident.

9. On 04/17/22 at 3:20am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 606 S. 5th Street. Upon approaching the tavern, officers observed several subjects inside the establishment that appeared to be drinking and when officers knocked to gain entry (the front door was locked), those subjects exited out the back door. The applicant admitted that there were non-employees inside the tavern but he could not control what his staff does or if they allow someone inside the tavern after hours. The applicant and staff were cooperative but the applicant was argumentative when questioned regarding the suspected violations.

On Sunday December 19th, 2021 at approximately 2:15 A.M. my partner and I responded to 606 S 5th St. (SNIFTERS Tapas & Spirit) to assist Squad 2341(PO GREER & PO WILCKENS) for a fight. Upon arrival I spoke to PO WILCKENS who stated there was a fight inside Snifters bar and the fight continued outside. PO WILCKENS stated he attempted to stop the fight outside but approximately 30 patrons from Snifters exited the bar and were fighting outside. PO WILCKENS stated he had to use his pepper spray in attempt to stop the fight. PO WILCKENS stated during the fight a female patron struck him several times and was taken into custody. PO WILCKENS stated that Snifter's security guards didn't attempt to stop the fight outside and went back into the tavern.

Upon entering the tavern I spoke with Julio C MALDONADO (W/M, 01/07/78), who stated he is the owner of the tavern. MALDONADO stated there was a fight inside the tavern over a stolen necklace. MALDONADO stated his security team escorted the fighting patrons outside and he didn't see what happened outside. I asked MALDONADO what was the capacity for his tavern and he stated it was 168. A check in City of Milwaukee license search revealed his capacity is 99 patrons permitted.

At 2:30 AM I observed several patron and employees inside the tavern with open intoxicants after I advised MALDONADO several times that all patrons must be out of the tavern by 2:30 AM.

Attempted to review Snifters surveillance footage regarding the fight MALDONADO was unable to operate his cameras and told us he will email us the surveillance footage.

operating a marked MPD squad car which is equipped with MDVR system. Officers were equipped with BWC which was on and activated, conducted a tavern check at the location of 606 S. 5th St, Snifters.

Upon approaching the business I observed through the open front window there were several subjects inside the bar that appeared to be drinking and essentially hanging out. Once I knocked on the front window and identified myself as the Milwaukee Police, I observed some of those subjects then go toward the back door of the bar. I later observed those subjects getting into vehicles that were parked on the adjacent street of the bar.

It took several moments before the bar's door was opened because they stated they had to get the key in order to open the business from the inside, and it appeared there was no interior door handle just a double deadbolt lock. I spoke to the owner Julio C. MALDONADO (M/W 01-07-1978) who stated that all the people inside the bar were workers and were helping clean up the bar. When asked about the people exiting out the back he stated that he could not control what his staff did or if they allowed someone into the bar. MALDONADO stated that he stopped serving alcohol prior to bar close but ultimately admitted that there were people besides workers inside the bar after bar close.

Squad 2410 (Sgt Stachoviak) informed me that he waited outside the bar for approximately 5 minutes before we conducted the tavern check and he observed subjects inside the bar who, upon entering the bar were snuck out the back door. A verbal warning was given regarding the after hours violation.

Licenses were not visible upon entering the bar. MALDONADO and staff were cooperative. MALDONADO was argumentative when questioned regarding the suspected violations.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 09/27/2022 at 02:30 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


