The City of Milwaukee negotiating team and Milwaukee District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, have reached agreement on compensation for certain employees in the Engineering Technician I and II classification while assigned to Road Life Work. This agreement is an implementation of the parties' interpretation of a grievance arbitration award. In order to implement this agreement, we need to amend the Salary Ordinance. We request that the Salary Ordinance be amended as follows:

Effective Pay Period 22, 2007, under Section 3, Pay Range 600, add the footnote designation "2/" after the title Engineering Technician I and add footnote 2/ to read as follows:

"2/Employees who are assigned to Road Life Work shall receive an additional \$0.75 per hour while assigned to that work."

Effective Pay Period 22, 2007, under Section 3, Pay Range 602, add the footnote designation "2/" after the title Engineering Technician II and add footnote 2/ to read as follows:

"2/Employees who are assigned to Road Life Work shall receive an additional \$0.75 per hour while assigned to that work."
