

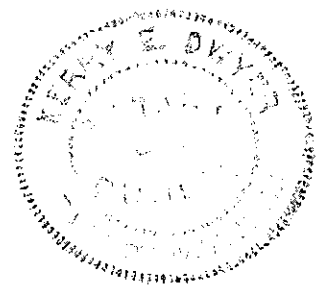

**081117...** A substitute ordinance relating to permitting planting in certain portions of the public right-of-way.

**081215...** A substitute ordinance establishing a capital improvements committee.

**081278...** A substitute ordinance relating to parking controls in various Aldermanic Districts.

**081279...** A substitute ordinance relating to traffic controls in various Aldermanic Districts.

**081282...** A substitute ordinance to further amend the 2009 rates of pay of offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council.

**081283...** A substitute ordinance to further amend the 2009 offices and positions in the City Service under control of the Common Council.

**081311...** Substitute ordinance relating to the First Amendment to a Detailed Planned Development known as RGS Warehouse, on lands located on the West Side of South 6th Street and North of West College Avenue, to allow for options to the approved building materials, in the 13th Aldermanic District.

**081369...** A substitute ordinance providing charges for violations relating to return of garbage and recycling carts to their original locations, mowing of grass, and removal of snow, ice and other debris from sidewalks.

**081387...** An ordinance prohibiting loitering in or about restaurants, taverns, convenience stores, filling stations and public buildings.

**081388...** An ordinance relating to sister cities policy.

**081398...** A substitute charter ordinance relating to retirement benefits and creditable service for employees represented by certain bargaining units.

**081415...** An ordinance relating to fees for horse stables and pet shops.

**081451...** A substitute charter ordinance relating to submission of budget estimates for the ensuing fiscal year.

**081475...** An ordinance relating to notice of actions subject to the review of the administrative review appeals board.
