There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this no

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

2. On 12/16/06 at 1:50 am, Milwaukee Police conduct a tavern check at 1460 W Muskego along with officers from the Intelligence Division and the Warrant Squad. Officers found the licensee, Gustavo Guizar, highly intoxicated and when advised the officers were there to conduct a tavern check, Guizar became argumentative with police. Guizar demanded that the police leave. While conducting the tavern check, officers located a loaded semi-auto pistol in a drawer under the cash register. Guizar stated to the police that the gun was his. Officers confiscated the firearm and placed it on inventory for safekeeping due to Guizar intoxication.

3. On 08/27/07 at 1:52 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1460 S Muskego for a Fight complaint. Officers spoke to Gustavo Guizar who stated that at about 1:00 am, he observed 5 subjects fighting inside the tavern and that it continued outside. Guizar stated the reason why he didn't call police right away because a patron who was hurt stated he was ok and Guizar believed police weren't needed. - 4. On 11/12/07 at 1:27 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1460 W Muskego for an Entry complaint. Investigation found that someone forced the front door open and removed \$500.00 dollars from two registers. A report was filed.
 - 5. On 02/18/12 at 2:15 am, an altercation happened inside The Tequilla Club between two groups of people. An officer spoke to Gustavo Guizar who stated he and his security escorted one group out the side door of the bar and then escorted the second group out the front door. A short time later a physical fight between the two groups occurred on the sidewalk in front of the club resulting in two battery victims. One victim was struck in the head with a bottle and needed 5 stitches to close the wound. The other victim was struck with a stick in the head and also required 5 stitches to close the wound. A charge of battery was issued to one suspect, which was no processed by the District Attorney.
 - 6. On 11/03/12 at 3:38 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1557 S 15th Street for a Property Damage complaint. Investigation found a patron entered the bar at 1460 S Muskego but was refused service due to his intoxication and was asked to leave. The patron then threatened to mess up one of the employee's car and upon leaving, broke the window to the employee's auto by throwing a brick at it.
 - 7. On 10/21/2013 the applicant was cited at 1912 West Rogers Street in the city of Milwaukee for Building Code Violations.

10. On 04/30/2016 Milwaukee police were dispatched to a battery/cutting at 1517 South Pearl Street. Investigation revealed the victim and suspect had been patrons of The Tequila Night Club (1460 South Muskego Avenue). The victim was approached by several people outside the business when a fight ensued, resulting in the death of the victim. Milwaukee police incident report #161210035 filed.

- 11. On 08/21/17 at 1:06 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1460 S. Muskego Avenue (Tequila Night Club) for a threat complaint. Upon arrival officers learned from the agent that an intoxicated patron made threats to shoot up the tavern. The agent decided to close the establishment early to prevent the subject from returning. No report was filed.
- 12. On 03/25/18 at 3:23 am, Milwaukee Police investigated a battery that took place at 1460 S. Muskego Avenue (Tequila Night Club). The investigation revealed that an assault happened inside the tavern earlier in the evening between three subjects. When the agent was contacted about the incident, he confirmed that it did happen inside the establishment and he called 911 but there was no police response. A later check by officers revealed that there were no incoming "calls for service" from the agent during the time of the incident. The surveillance system for the tavern was not functioning at the time of the assault and officers observed that the Class B Tavern license for the establishment was not hanging prominently on the wall. The agent was advised about the license and a citation was issued to the battery suspect.

13. On 02/20/2020 at 11:48pm officers were dispatched to a call for Police at 1460 S Muskego Av. The officer spoke with the female caller who stated she had a problem with a man in the bar and she pepper sprayed him. The male was not on scene. The applicant was on scene and provided the officers with video of the incident. The video shows the female and male kissing and then start pushing each other. The male is then seen seated at the opposite side of the bar when the female approaches him and pepper sprays him. No one from the bar called regarding the incident.

14. On 05/20/23 at 11:38p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 1454 S. Muskego Av. Investigation revealed the victim, not a patron, was traveling in a car and continued to drive away from the scene after being shot. It was determined he was shot in the shoulder. Officers recovered a total of 17 9mm casings at the scene and observed multiple

bullet strikes to the bar at 1460 S Muskego Av. The agent was interviewed regarding the incident. The agent stated they were threatened earlier in the day by the boyfriend of a tenant that he evicted and believed they were involved in the shooting. Video surveillance from both the tavern and a nearby business revealed a vehicle dropped off the suspect. The suspect is seen walking past the tavern. The suspect then re-entered the vehicle and fired shots out of the window of the vehicle towards the bar.

A suspect was developed and arrested. (boyfriend the agent referred to during his interview) The suspect stated they were threatened earlier in the day by the agent at 1460 S Muskego Av and called the police. Police were unable to make contact with the caller/suspect to investigate the reckless use of a weapon complaint. The suspect denied involvement with the shooting. (2 reports)

a shooting which occurred at the location of 1460 S. Muskego Av. This report is a brief summary and description of the incident that occurred.

A total of 17, 9mm casings were recovered on scene, and a victim was shot once in his shoulder while being dropped off at the location by his friends. During the investigation a suspect, Joseph AUSTIN, was developed and subsequently arrested. AUSTIN, during a Mirandized interview, stated he was at his former residence attempting to pick up his mail at 1460 S Muskego Street. During his attempt to pick the mail up he interacted with his former landlord Gustavo (and agent of Tequila Night Club). AUSTIN stated he was threatened by Gustavo who patted on his right hip to advise AUSTIN he was armed with a handgun. AUSTIN stated Gustavo then told him "I have something for you, POW POW!" AUSTIN stated Gustavo always has a handgun on his person because he is at his business on the ground floor of the building that is some type of Tequila Bar. AUSTIN stated he left the location, but then came back because his children were still in the apartments above the bar. AUSTIN stated he was not allowed into the apartment building by Gustavo.

AUSTIN was questioned about the shooting investigation that took place. AUSTIN stated he was present at the 1460 S. Muskego address because he was moving out the residence that day. AUSTIN denied any involvement with any shots fired that happened at the bar that day. AUSTIN stated he does not possess any firearms and he carries knives and at times a machete for personal protection. AUSTIN stated the bar has shots fired incidents on a very frequent basis.

On Saturday, May 20th, 2023, PO Josue AYALA and I (Squad 2442, in full duty uniform and equipped with Axon body worn cameras) were dispatched to assist with a shooting complaint located at 1454 S. Muskego Ave, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

Initial Response:

Upon arrival PO AYALA and I helped check for a victim and the scene. We were notified by family of the victim that the victim had left the scene. He was located with a graze wound to the shoulder, but they pointed out roughly where the gun shots had come from.

PO AYALA and I checked near the intersection of S Muskego Av and W Bow St. While checking for the scene we did locate several holes in a bar located at 1460 S Muskego Av (The Tequila Night Club). I went to the gas station at 1421 S Cesar E Chavez Dr to check for video of the suspect vehicle.

Interview of GUIZAR:

PO AYALA made contact with the owner of The Tequila Night Club, who identified himself as Gustavo GUIZAR (W/M, 08-08-57). GUIZAR stated to PO AYALA that earlier in the day a subject he knows as "Joseph AUSTIN" threatened to slash his tires. GUIZAR stated that AUSTIN is the boyfriend of one of his tenants that was getting evicted. GUIZAR stated that he believed that AUSTIN may have shot at the tavern out of anger.

This interview was recorded on PO AYALA's body worn camera, but the majority of this interview is done inside of the bar which has loud music in the background.

Detectives were notified on scene of GUIZAR's statements.

Video Review:

Officers reviewed video at the bar and made the following notes in the CAD.

Comment: BAR AT 1460 S MUSKEGO HAS CAMERA FOOTAGE / SUSP VEH IS A RED OR BLK OLDER MODEL JEEP OR MOUNTAINEER SUV / LS WB ON ARROW FROM MUSKEGO / 3 BULLET STRIKES TO THE BAR AS WELL, Comment: PER VIDEO / HARD TO TELL IF VIC WAS THE INTENDED TARGET / SUSP VEH STOPPED AT MUSKEGO AND BOW / SUSP WALKS SB FROM GREENFIELD AFTER GETTING DROPPED OFF / SUSP THEN GETS BACK IN AND FIRES SHOTS OUT THE WINDOW

Additional Information:

It should be noted that at 6:06 p.m. on May 20th, 2023, a Joseph AUSTIN called police regarding a male subject, 62 years old, named Gustavo pulled a gun on him and threatened to shoot him at 1521 S 10th St. Officers responded to this call for service on May 21st, 2023, at 1:37 a.m. but were unable to locate or get make contact with AUSTIN.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/28/2023 at 1:55 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
