- Restore house to original details and dimensions
- Full Roof tear off and restoration.
- Install appropriate half round gutters and downspouts
- Remove Chimney
- Repair roof gable eaves – soffits, barge boards, trim etc.



- Front Porch repair or replace columns.
- Rebuild brick piers and wingwalls
- Replace decking and railings.
- Repair and/or replace skirting.



- Remove secondary siding and restore wood siding and trim



- Rear bump out requires new roofing.
