You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on July 6, 2005 commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202 to consider your Class "B" Tavern renewal application for the premises at 3515 West Villard Avenue in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Conversations").

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee which includes their Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation, recommending renewal with a fifteen (15) day suspension of the Class "B" Tavern license. The recommendation is the result of a public hearing before the Committee held on June 21, 2005, a police report and neighborhood objections.

You may file a written objection to the Report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee and shall have the opportunity to present arguments in writing supporting that objection to the Common Council. You or a legal representative may also appear at the Common Council meeting and request an opportunity to address the Common Council for approximately five (5) minutes to present an oral argument on your own behalf.
