To Whom It May Concern:

I am in receipt of your letter dated October 31, 2002 in which you state the tow of my car was legal.

I live on Milwaukee's east side, in an impacted parking area. My address is 1104 N. Marshall St. I have the appropriate permits for both day and night parking in this area. Both permits are displayed clearly, in the right places, in my car.

The night of September 23, 2002 I parked on the north side of Kilbourn St., at the west end of the block between Astor and Marshall streets. My car was in the spot at the far west end of the block. Parking is allowed here with the night permit. This parking spot is about three blocks from my home. I usually park closer, but was unable to find anything closer on the night of the 23rd.

My car was towed on 9/24/02 from this spot. There was a "Temporary no parking" sign posted on the light post in the middle of the block, apparently for construction reasons. There were no obvious signs of construction on the night of the 23rd--no barricades, no holes, no heavy equipment. The no parking sign was about 50 feet from my parking spot.

This no parking sign was impossible to see from where I parked. I had not parked on Kilbourn for several weeks, because it is so far from home. The sign was not there last time I parked on Kilbourn. I could not see the sign because it was dark, and it was not in sight range of my car. Additionally, the sign was facing east on the post, while I was at the west end of the block.

I make every effort to comply with Milwaukee's complex parking regulations. Parking is limited on the east side, and is very difficult at best. I was in a legal parking spot, and had the proper permits.

I appeared in person at the City Attorney's Office on October 4, 2002. They initially told me they wouldn't talk to me about this matter, even though theirs was the address given to me at the city tow lot. After a one hour wait, I talked with Mr. Unora. He said he couldn't help me, and gave me your address.

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
