This grant opportunity will provide funds to purchase a new server for the WiWATCH Portal.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Through utilization of the Nationwide Suspicious Activity Reporting Initiative (NSI), the Southeastern Threat Analysis Center (STAC) can utilize an "all crimes" approach to preventing crime and terrorism. The NSI provides a national capability to gather, document, process, analyze, and share information among various state, local, tribal, and federal agencies. The general public through the online WiWATCH Portal submits their criminal or terrorist activity observations through the Suspicious Activity Report (SAR). The server houses the Southeastern Threat Analysis Center (STAC) and Wisconsin Statewide Intelligence Center (WSIC) contact information and is used by citizens to report suspicious activity electronically by accessing the website.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

The current STAC server is outdated and experiencing technical issues. Also provided is the "See Something, Say Something" information for the businesses and citizens for the entire State of Wisconsin, not just the STAC area of responsibility.
