Dear City Plan Commission and Alderman Chambers,

I am writing to reiterate my unwavering opposition to the proposed data center developments at 60th and Capitol (File Nos. 260029 and 260030).

While I note that these items were removed from the May 18th agenda for "further review," my stance remains unchanged: An industrial data hub has no place in the heart of a residential community.

My opposition is based on the following non-negotiable points:

Inappropriate Land Use: The intersection of 60th and Capitol is a vital community hub. Dedicating this space to "High Performance Computing" rather than accessible retail, housing, or community services is a direct disservice to the neighbors who actually live here.

Irreversible Environmental Damage: Data centers are notorious for high energy consumption and noise pollution. Regardless of "detailed information" provided by the developer, the risk of grid instability and the constant hum of cooling infrastructure will permanently degrade the quality of life for residents on 58th Street and the surrounding blocks.

Lack of Community Benefit: This project offers virtually no local employment opportunities while placing the burden of resource consumption on Milwaukee taxpayers.

I urge the Commission to reject these files outright rather than seeking ways to "mitigate" an inherently flawed proposal. I will continue to monitor the agenda and will be present to voice this opposition at the rescheduled hearing.
