File # 050857 is a resolution authorizing the Milwaukee Police Department to accept and fund an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to apply for a Justice Assistance grant for the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance. This is a new grant program.
- 2. This grant program replaces the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program that has ended. This block grant had funded law enforcement agencies to purchase equipment that serves a law enforcement objective.
- 3. This is a new grant.
- 4. File # 041599 authorized the Milwaukee Police Department to apply for this grant.

Discussion

- 1. MPD plans to use these grant funds to update technology deemed to be necessary for law enforcement purposes.
- 2. MPD has determined that the equipment purchase outlined in the fiscal effect section would best serve its current technology equipment needs.
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2008.

Fiscal Effect

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$410,650, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. This funding will provide for the following:

• Computer equipment \$306,000

• Cameras and support software for 5 MPD conveyance vehicles \$104,650
