We have received your claim relating to damage allegedly sustained to your vehicle when it was towed to the City of Milwaukee Tow Low.

Our investigation reveals that your vehicle was towed on April 27, 2006 for being Illegally Parked. The PT-27 form, completed prior to the tow, indicates damage to the front end and that the left side front signal was broken. The Tow Lot Vehicle Inventory Form, completed upon arrival and departure at the tow lot, and intake video also indicates damage to the front lights. There was no evidence of radiator damage. This alleged damage would not be caused by typical towing or storage of the vehicle. The damage to your vehicle appears to have happened prior to the tow. As such, the City cannot accept liability. Therefore, we are denying your claim.
