Dear Commissioner Korban,

This letter is in regards to a special privilege granted to Noble I Milwaukee OPCO, LLC, d/b/a Hyatt Regency Milwaukee ("Hyatt") on November 14, 2007 by Resolution of the Milwaukee Common Council.

The special privilege allowed the Hyatt to place and maintains five concrete benches in the west, 25-foot wide sidewalk area of North Old World Third Street between West Wells Street and West Kilbourn Avenue. Said concrete benches are 2 feet wide and 7 feet long. Additionally, the above-referenced Resolution stated the 5 concrete benches may be removed for any reason whatsoever, including public necessity whenever so ordered by resolution adopted by the Common Council.

As part of this special privilege, the Hyatt hereby relinquishes all ownership rights of the 5 concrete benches to the City of Milwaukee and also shall not be entitled to any form of compensation or damages for the removal of said benches for such purposes described herein. Furthermore, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works or a person appointed as the Commissioner's designee may reuse or destroy said benches at the discretion of the Commissioner.
