Dear Committee Members:

To implement the 2001-2002 labor agreement between the City of Milwaukee and Local 75, AFL-CIO, the wage rates for the Landscape and Irrigation Specialist covered by this Agreement are tied to the wage rates for the Union and the Contractors Association for Journeymen Plumbers for the period from June 1, 2002, up to and including May 31, 2003. Plumbers' Local #75 has provided us with the new rates that are effective June 1, 2002.

In order to implement the wage rate changes effective Pay Period 13, 2002, as required by the labor agreement, we are requesting your approval of the following amendment to the Salary Ordinance:

Under Section 17, effective Pay Period 13, 2002, delete the rates of pay shown and substitute the hourly rate of \$25.72 and biweekly rate of \$2,057.60.

In view of the foregoing, I recommend the adoption of this amendment to the Salary Ordinance.
