REASON FOR REQUEST:

Bradley Johnson, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and on bicycle patrol traveling westbound on Lincoln Avenue in a marked bicycle lane. After proceeding through the intersection of West Lincoln Avenue and South 11th Street, Officer Johnson was struck from behind by an intoxicated, uninsured motorist, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

As a result of the impact, Officer Johnson was thrown from his bicycle and sustained injuries to his chin/face, neck, back, knees, and elbows. A low back surgery was performed as a result of the incident and the physicians have indicated he sustained a permanent injury. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$161,252.55.
