### **Levying of Taxes for the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District Capital Purposes for the 2009 Fiscal Year**

RESOLVED, by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage Commission, that to finance the acquisition, extension, planning, design, construction, adding to, or improvement of land, waters, property, or facilities for sewerage purposes and to pay principal and interest on bonds and notes as provided in the 2009 fiscal year capital budget of the District, there is hereby levied upon all taxable property in the District (as equalized for State purposes), pursuant to Sec. 200.55(6), Stats., a non-repealable, direct annual tax in an amount sufficient for the purposes listed below, which tax shall be in addition to all other State taxes:

- a. \$27,269,000 for debt service coming due in 2009 on outstanding general obligations of the District (for which a non-repealable direct annual tax has previously been levied by the Commission) less amounts recorded in the debt service fund created for the general obligation bonds; and
- b. \$54,146,000 for debt service coming due in 2009 on outstanding general obligations of the District that were sold to the State of Wisconsin Clean Water Fund Program (for which a non-repealable direct annual tax has previously been levied by the Commission) less amounts recorded in the debt service fund created for the general obligation bonds; and
- c. \$1,040,000 for debt service coming due in 2009 on new anticipated general obligations of the District to be sold to the State of Wisconsin Clean Water Fund Program; and
- d. \$3,000 to finance a portion of the 2009 fiscal year capital budget

totaling \$82,458,000 shall be carried on to the tax roll of each city, town, or village wholly or partially within the boundaries of the District and collected in addition to all other taxes and in the same manner and at the same time, all as provided by law.
