This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 05/13/20 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery complaint at Noir Wireless and Grocery. The caller stated a minor from a local group home entered the store and left with a Black & Mild Cigar. The caller stated she went in and confronted the clerk (Salem S. HASAN), who denied selling the cigar to the minor. The caller further stated the clerk came from behind the glass, putting his hand around her face and pushed her away. The clerk denied these allegations to officers, and stated he didn't speak or understand English. The owner (Bashar R. Khader) was contacted and stated he was having difficulties with his surveillance cameras and therefore, could not provide officers with video of the incident. Khader stated he was working on the system and would try to get police video. Khader further stated "King Rick' from the Original Black Panthers confronted the clerk on 5/16/20 and advised if he wasn't fired the next time he came into the store there would be problems.

On Tuesday, May 19, 2020, at approximately 2:09 PM, Squad 7233 (P.O. Billie ELLIS and I in full duty uniform equipped with Axon body worn cameras and operating marked MPD squad 427) conducted follow up at the address of 4025 W. Burleigh St, Noil Wireless and Groceries, located within the City and

County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The below report is a summary based on recollection and is not a verbatim retelling of the events captured on the body worn cameras.

I spoke with the owner identified as Bashar R. KHADER (b/f 09-14-73) who stated since our last contact he still has not been able to figure out the surveillance system to show us the recording from May 13, 2020. KHADER stated he is still trying to make contact with the previous owner on how to control the playback. KHADER appeared to try and get the system to work but could not get it to function. KHADER was advised the store clerk would be receiving a citation for the allegations made by Tracey D. HULL (b/f 09-06-70) for disorderly conduct.

KHADER stated he was still going to try and pull up the video to show police. KHADER also showed me a video of the Original Black Panthers of Milwaukee confronting the clerk about the incident on Saturday, May 16, 2020. The individual in the video identified as "King Rick" stated if the clerk was not fired the next time he comes into the store there were going to be problems. KHADER was advised to call police if they return and cause a disturbance.

I changed locations to 2967 N. 38th St. to make contact with HULL and also speak with the 12 year old who allegedly purchased the tobacco products from the store.

### Interview with Leona J. HICKS (b/f 08-09-07)

HICKS stated the incident occurred at approximately 2:40 PM. HICKS stated she goes to the store frequently and has bought black and mild tobacco products from the store before. HICKS stated she walked in the store and purchased one and walked out.

HICKS stated sometimes she purchases them and sometimes he gives them out for free. HICKS stated after she walked outside HULL saw that she had the tobacco product in her hand. HICKS stated that's when HULL went to go confront the store clerk. HICKS stated the clerk denied over and over again that he did not sell the tobacco product to her. HICKS stated she observed the store clerk come from behind the glass and push HULL in the face while telling her to leave the store. HICKS stated that's when HULL contacted the police.

This report is written by P.O. Justino RODRIGUEZ assigned to District 7, Power Shift.

On Wednesday, May 13, 2020, at approximately 3:26 PM, Squad 7233 (P.O. Angel GALLEGOS and I in full duty uniform equipped with Axon body worn cameras and operating marked MPD squad 164) was dispatched to a Battery call for service at 2967 N. 39th St. Upon arrival we spoke with a younger black female who stated the caller later identified as Tracey D. HULL (b/f 09-06-70) who stated she pushed in the face by a clerk who works at a corner store located at 4025 W. Burleigh St, Noil Wireless and Grocery, located within the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

HULL stated one of the residents of the group home Leona HICKS (b/f 08-09-07) walked into the store and came out with a black & mild tobacco product. HULL stated when she confronted the store clerk about it, the clerk advised her that HICKS did not buy anything. HULL stated she could not have gotten the black and mild tobacco from anywhere else. HULL stated the clerk came out from behind the glass, put his hand around her face and pushed her away. HULL stated that is when she called police.

We attempted to speak with the clerk later identified as Salem S. HASAN (w/m 12-17-84) who stated he could not speak any English. When HASAN was asked if anything occurred with any female customer to which he only shook his head no and stated he was calling someone.

The owner later identified as Bashar R. KHADER (w/m 09-14-73) stated his employee does not understand English well. KHADER stated he does have a surveillance system but he has been having issues with it and could not playback the video. KHADER stated he would try to get it fixed as soon as possible and would contact us when the video is ready to be viewed. KHADER stated they have signs posted up on the front glass near the cash register to which he pointed out and stated they do not sell any tobacco products to minors. KHADER stated this is the first time this type of allegation has been made against his store and taking this very seriously.

KHADER stated HASAN was denying the allegations and if HULL came in their causing a disturbance and

they needed to push her out they would'e filed a complaint themselves. KHADER was issued a contact card and advised to call us as soon as he gets the surveillance system working.

We attempted to interview HICKS but HULL stated she went to a friends house. HULL stated she would be working tomorrow and could contact us so we could respond and get an official statement. HULL was issued a contact card.



The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 7/10/2020 at 10:35 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
