**Property** 807 E. BRADY ST. Brady Street Historic District  
**Description of work** Owner proposes to replace steel service door at southwest rear corner of the building. New door will be commercial grade heavy duty metal flush door with new frame and threshold. It will be painted to match previous door. Old broken asphalt at the rear small driveway will be replaced with new and pitched properly to divert water away from the building. The painting of the exterior, started last year, will be completed.

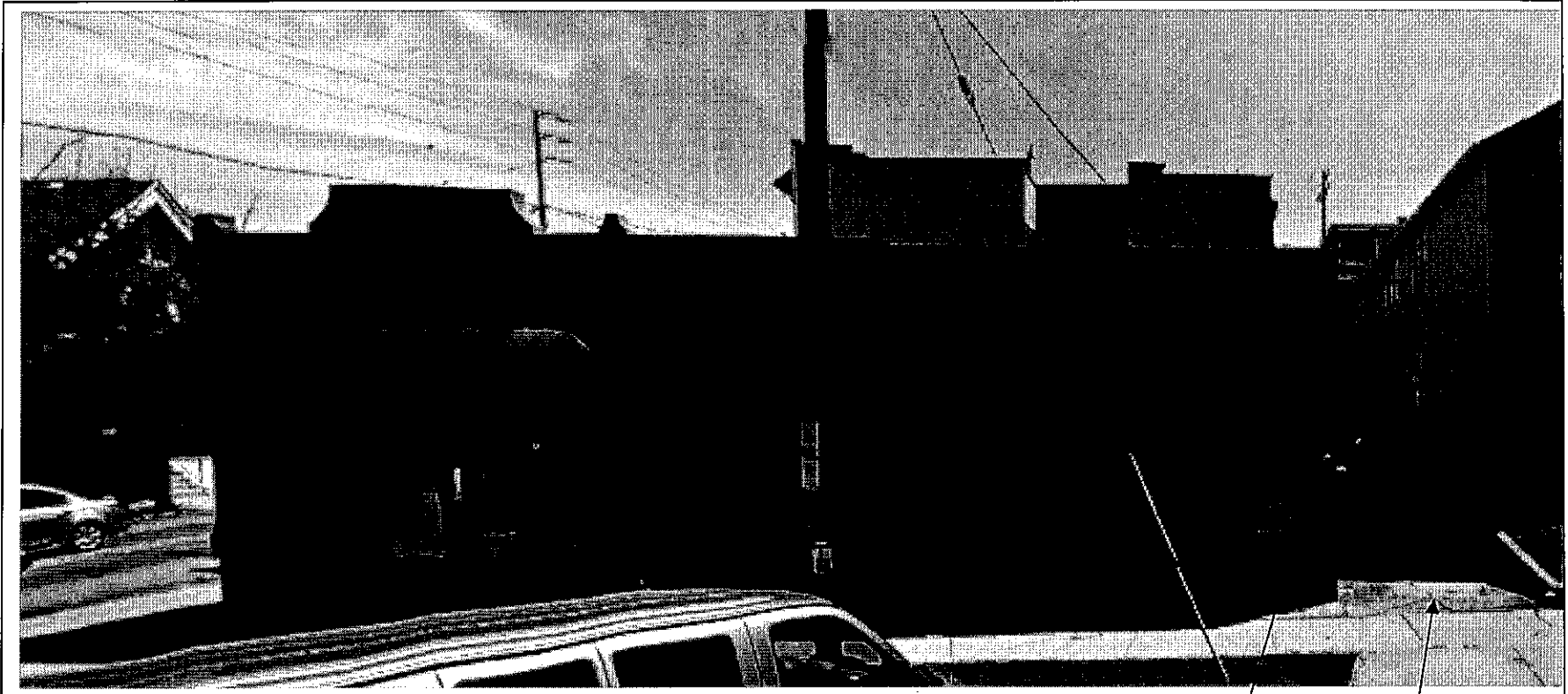
All work to be completed according to the application.
