File # 030555 is a resolution relative to application, acceptance and funding of a 2002 COPS Secure Our Schools Grant and authorizing a sub-grant to the Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) for security measures in public schools.

## **Background**

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Police Department to apply for, accept and fund a 2002 COPS Secure Our Schools grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services.
- 2. This is a new grant.

# **Discussion**

- 1. The purpose of this grant is to improve safety in and around schools.
- 2. MPS applied for this grant but federal rules require that a law enforcement agency be the receiver of the grant funds.
- 3. This grant encompasses the period of September 1, 2002 though August 31, 2003.

## **Fiscal Impact**

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$1,431,472 with \$639,287 to be provided by the grantor. This amount represents a sub-grant to MPS to be passed through MPD.
- 2. There is no fiscal impact to the city.
- 3. MPS will provide a 55% match, \$792,185, as a contribution to this program.
