REASON FOR REQUEST:

Louis Kopesky, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling southbound on South 26th Street. As the City vehicle entered the intersection of West National Avenue and South 26th, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling westbound on West National Avenue at an excessive rate of speed, struck the City vehicle causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Kopesky sustained injuries to his head, neck and left shoulder. The treating physician indicated the left shoulder injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$63,274.03.
