Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 111457

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 111457, being a resolution to amend a special privilege for addition of a second storm enclosure, a line fence, two moveable planters, an ice cooler and a grease trap in the public right-of-way for the premises at 338 South 1st Street.

In 2003 under Common Council Resolution File Number 021088, Slims Florida LLC, the applicant, was granted permission to construct and maintain a storm enclosure in the north sidewalk area of East Florida Street. Presently, the applicant is requesting permission to construct and maintain a second storm enclosure located at its entrance at the intersection of East Florida Street and South 1st Street. A site visit revealed the presence of two moveable planters, ice cooler, grease trap and line fence in the public right-of-way. A minimum 5-foot wide clear path for pedestrian traffic was present adjacent to the subject premises and all items in the public right-of-way.

We are not aware that the presence of said items has had or will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said items to continue to occupy the public right-of-way.
