

The necessary legislation will be prepared for consideration at the next Public Safety and Health Committee meeting for the above captioned parking restriction changes, so that you may support it to final passage.

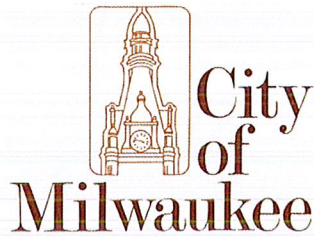



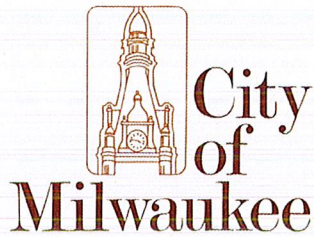
