

REASON FOR REQUEST:

Kurt Lacina, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in a City of Milwaukee squad car that was travelling southbound on North 6<sup>th</sup> Street. After the City vehicle stopped at the intersection of North 6<sup>th</sup> Street and West State Street, the alleged uninsured motorist, who was travelling southbound on North 6<sup>th</sup> Street, failed to yield the right of way and rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to section 62.67 Stats. and the City of Milwaukee's uninsured motorist self-insurance plan.

Officer Lacina sustained injuries to his neck and low back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages are in excess of \$115,000.00. Although the negligent driver may have been covered by a liability insurance policy, it would cost significantly more than this recommended settlement to pursue that possible defense.
