# EQUITABLE SHARING PROGRAM

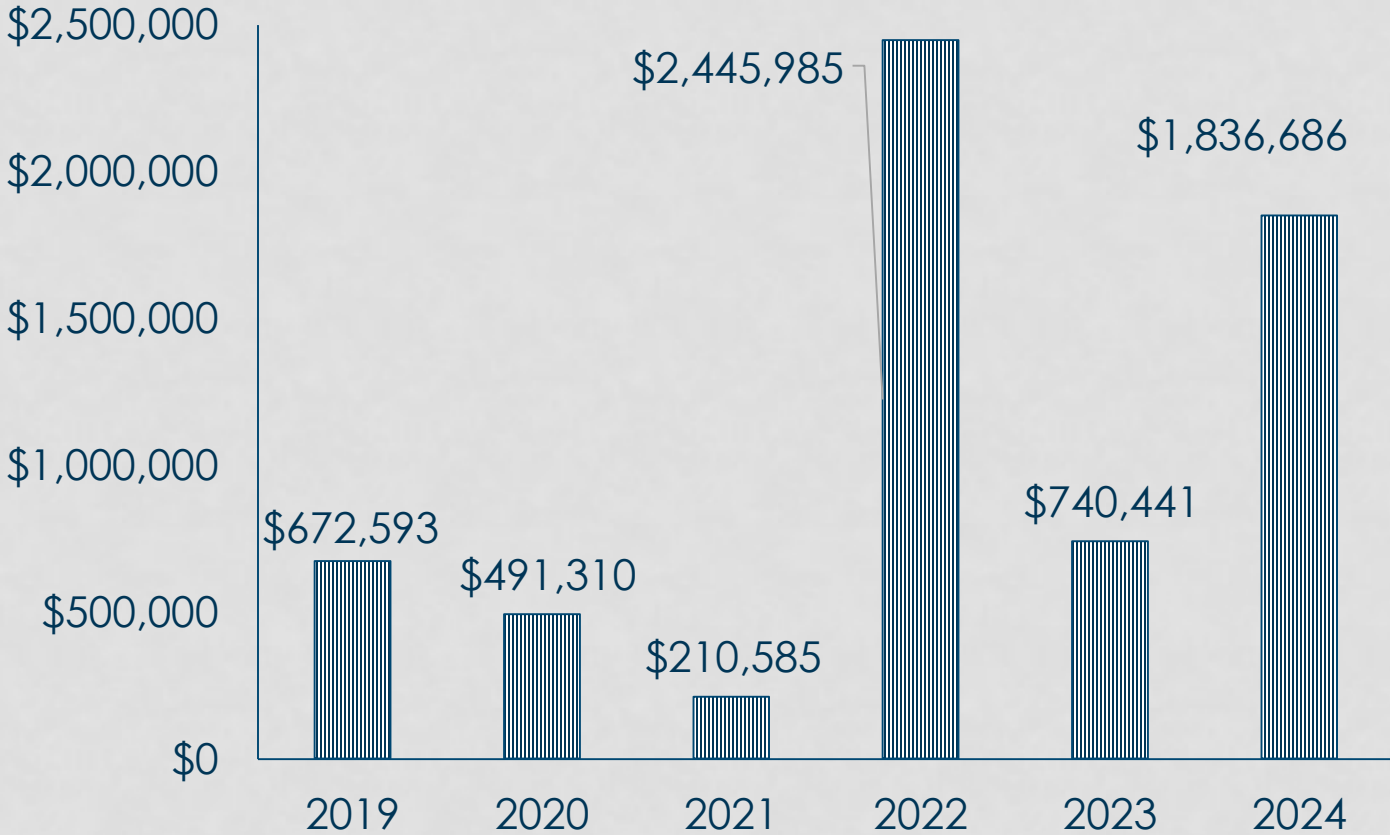
## ASSET FORFEITURE

- The Equitable Sharing or “Asset Forfeiture” program is run through the US Department of Justice.
- The program allows for the distribution of assets seized from illegal activity where proof of the property’s connection to criminal activity has been established and conviction has occurred.
- The program’s 4 goals include: punish and deter criminal activity; promote cooperation among law enforcement agencies; compensate victims; and, administer the program professionally in a manner consistent program guidelines and sound public policy.
- As a local law enforcement agency, the Milwaukee Police Department is eligible to participate in the program and to receive an “equitable share” of assets seized.
- It may be many years between the date an asset is seized and the receipt of MPD’s equitable share of the asset.

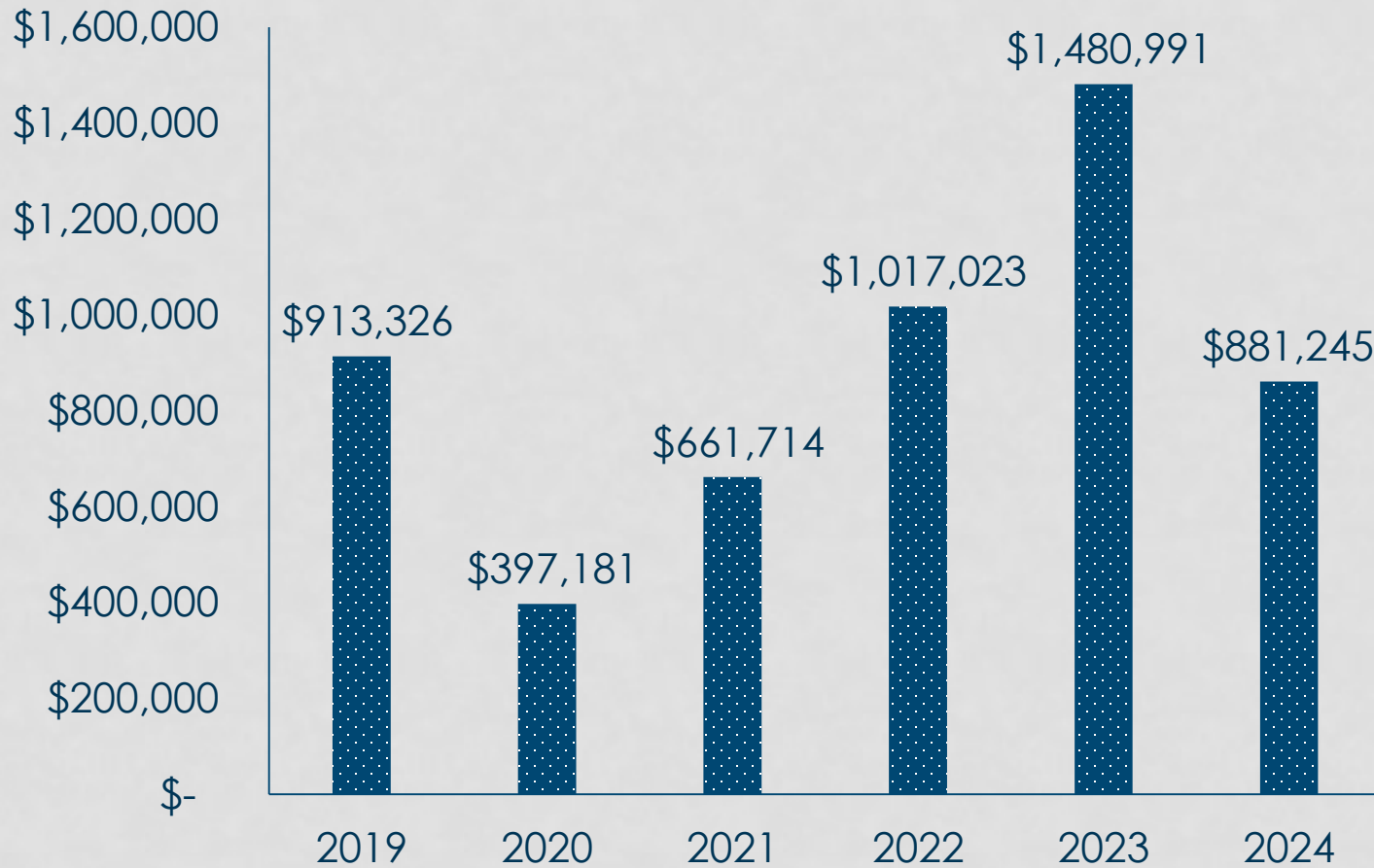

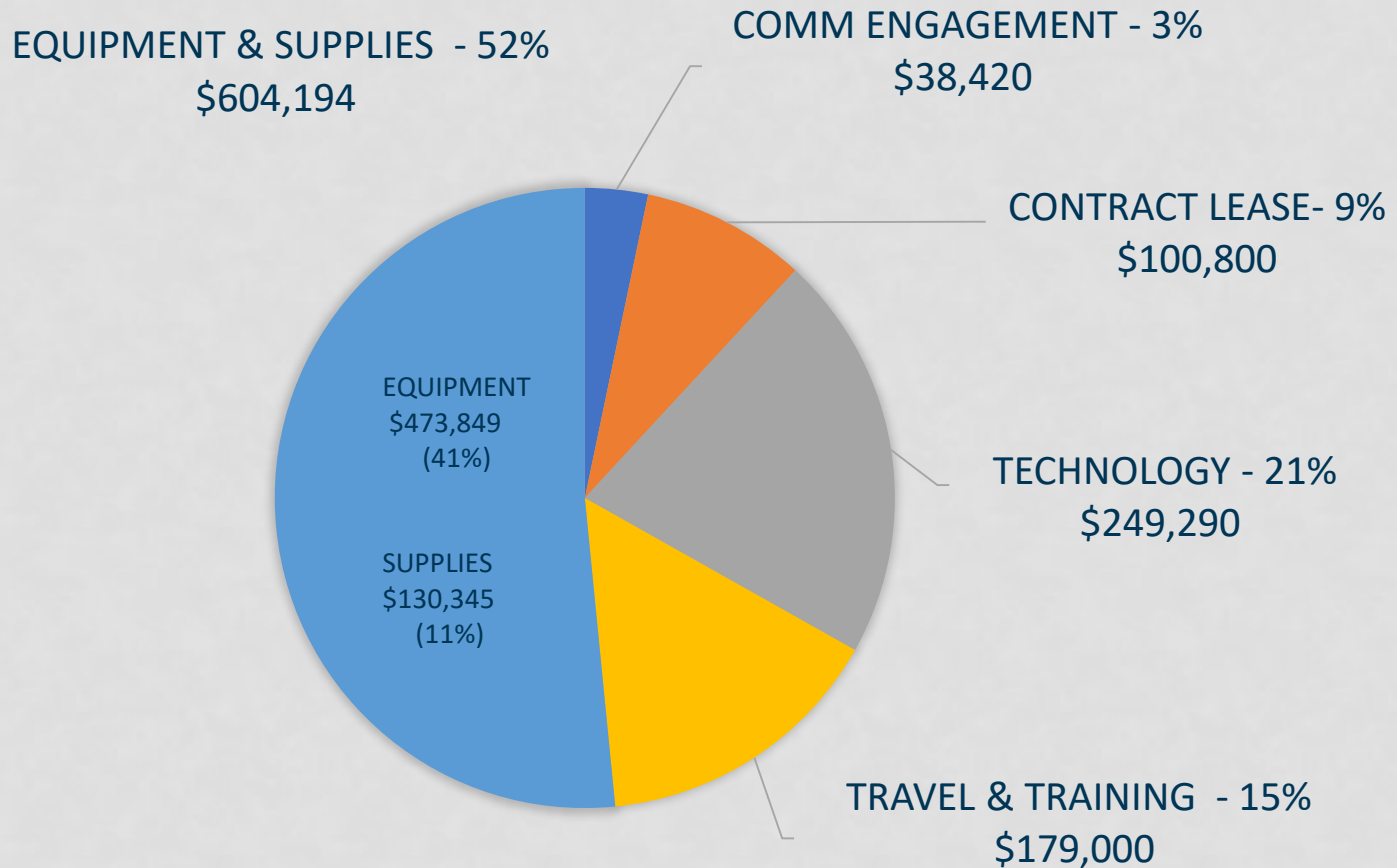

# 2025 COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Category: Community Engagement
- Proposed: \$ 38,420 (3%)
- Projects:

Promotional items/wearables for recruitment, community engagement (cops & conversation, MPD Haunted Academy), and police athletic league.



# 2025 CONTRACT FOR FACILITY LEASE

- Category: Contract for Facility Lease
- Proposed: \$100,800 (9%)
- 1 Project:

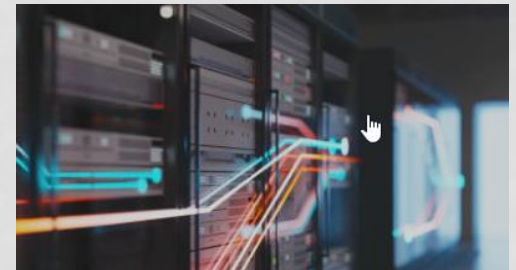

## 2025 TECHNOLOGY

- Category: Technology
- Proposed: \$249,290 (21%)
- 7 Projects:

Various projects including, \$123,000 for gladiator cell phone tracking program in MPD Special Investigations Division, \$55,000 for redaction system, \$28,000 for video wall upgrade in Fusion Division, and \$20,000 for server storage to accommodate pole camera video.



## 2025 TRAINING & TRAVEL

- Category : Training & Travel
- Requests: \$179,000 (15%)
- 5 Projects:

Fund for various department training, including \$90,000 for a department-wide fund, \$45,000 for the airborne assessment team, \$24,000 to train new polygraph examiners, \$12,000 for forensic identification and \$8,000 for fingerprint training.



## 2025 EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES

- Category: Equipment & Supplies
- Projects: \$ 604,194 (52%)
- 68 Projects:

Including \$250,000 to expand drone pilot program, \$83,000 for 8 portable meridian barriers & related equipment to protect restricted areas, \$45,000 for forensic full spectral camera device, \$17,000 for simunition protective clothing and marking cartridges, \$11,000 patrol shield light, \$5,700 for MAC studio computer, \$5,000 canine vehicle safety system, \$4,900 for drug testing fume hoods, and various smaller equipment and kits.
