The purpose of the grant is to create a data collection system/repository of criminal justice and partner information to carry out the necessary research and analysis from a merged data set to determine the effectiveness of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council's Evidence Based Decision Making Initiative.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The Milwaukee County Safety Data Repository Grant and subsequent activity will assist the Commission and its member agencies to fulfill the legislative mandate of the Common Council to "increase safety for victims of domestic violence and their children and victims of sexual assault..." The overarching goal of the site and associated services will be to protect victim safety and confidentiality and protect children from witnessing violence, being abducted, or experiencing abuse or sexual violence during visitation and exchanges.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Coordinating Council is 4 years old. Each voting member represents an agency, institution or community stakeholder actively engaged in or a part of the local and statewide criminal justice system.
