To Whom It May Concern,

This letter is intended to serve as a complaint against Abyss Towing, located at 960 W. Armour Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53221, regarding ordinance violations related to a non-consensual towing incident. [REDACTED], was towed from a private business parking lot on [REDACTED] Milwaukee, WI. The time of tow is listed on the receipt as 11 PM. While I am not disputing that I was illegally parked and rightfully towed, during attempts to recover my vehicle on [REDACTED] yss Towing violated more than one ordinance, as follows in both a narrative and list of specific complaints. Throughout this entire incident, two witnesses, [REDACTED] were present with me and can attest to the veracity of this report.

I made an initial attempt to recover my vehicle on November 6, 2015 at 960 W. Armour Ave., but was told by the tow truck operator that the business was closed and I would have to wait until the next morning to recover it. I called the business the next morning and was told I would need \$340 cash, a valid ID and vehicle registration to recover my vehicle between the hours of 9AM and 12 PM. Upon arrival, I was met by a woman who got out of what I assume to be a personal vehicle, with a clipboard in hand, as there is apparently no office or building associated with this business. At this time, my car was parked in an enclosed, locked, outdoor area. I presented my driver's license and a copy of my vehicle registration to indicate that I had a right to claim the vehicle in question, which was taken as acceptable identification to reclaim the vehicle by the business. I then proceeded to dispute the amount charged and the business practice of only accepting cash, based on city ordinances, as I preferred to pay via debit or credit card to have an electronic record of the transaction. This was denied me. I attempted to involve law enforcement via a non-emergency route, as I believed I was being unfairly and perhaps illegally treated by a company performing a non-consensual service, but was told that this was a civil matter in which I could file complaint or take it to court. Upon hearing this, I returned to the woman representing Abyss Towing and indicated that I would like to inspect my car, see my receipt and pay the fee. I was told that I was not allowed to inspect my car for damages prior to paying, but that I would first need to pay the entire towing fee by cash and sign the business paperwork. Only then, would she allow me to see my receipt, and following that, see my car. When I stated that I would not give the business cash (at this time I displayed cash, to indicate that I did in fact have it) unless I had first or simultaneously received a copy of the receipt, the woman stated that they would simply not give me my car back and I could wait until Monday, since they were closed Sunday, and pay an additional \$60 in fees for storage. When I challenged this, referring to city ordinances, she agreed only to hand me the receipt at the same time I handed her cash, after signing her paperwork, without first allowing me to inspect my

car. After the exchange of the cash and the receipt, the outdoor lot was unlocked for me and I was allowed to retrieve my car with the woman following me. After I retrieved my car, the woman and all other parties at the lot got in their personal vehicles and left, closing the lot prior to the stated closing time of 12PM. Throughout the encounter, I was verbally berated by the woman, though I remained calm and merely restated what I believed my rights were, as my witnesses can attest.

1) I am certain my rights were violated when I was not allowed to inspect my vehicle prior to paying Abyss Towing for services and, again, when it was demanded that I sign the business's paperwork prior to seeing my vehicle. Milwaukee City Ordinance 93-47 states in section 5 that "No towing business shall solicit, demand or receive any payment for services provided or waiver of the right to contest damages prior to allowing the owner or authorized operator of a towed vehicle a reasonable opportunity to inspect the vehicle for damages or loss of contents."

2) Secondly, I believe that I was charged an improper amount for a non-consensual tow in the City of Milwaukee. The paper receipt that I received indicated handwritten amounts of \$30 fee for the City, \$30 storage fee, \$150 towing fee, and a \$130 Special Equipment fee (not otherwise described in the document). (See scanned copy for details)

s. Trans 319.03 Wis. Admin. Code outlines a maximum that a business performing a non-consensual tow can charge:

- \$150 for the total towing fee, regardless of whether the tow is via a flat bed, hook and chain, wheel lift, sling or belt lift, boom tow or other method.

- \$30 per 24 hours that the vehicle is stored in an outdoor facility.

- Fees related to special or unusual towing circumstances not to exceed \$150.

- Fee not to exceed \$35 to be passed along to the municipality in which the tow is performed, if requested by that municipality.

There were no special or unusual circumstances related to this tow, as I was towed from a surface lot and possess a vehicle of normal size and good repair. Additionally, the lot was largely empty and the weather clear. I believe the \$130 special equipment fee should not have been charged.

I also believe the \$30 storage fee should not have been charged. City of Milwaukee ordinance Chapter 93-47 governs non-consensual towing of vehicles. In section 4h, it states a company performing a non-consensual tow cannot "Charge the owner or authorized operator of any non-consensually towed motor vehicle any storage fee for any 24-hour period during which the business is not open and the vehicle not available for recovery for at least a 4 hour period between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m." Abyss Towing stated their Saturday hours as 9a.m. to 12 p.m. and, on this occasion, closed early, which does not meet the 4 hour requirement necessary to charge the storage fee.

Additionally and aside, I was threatened with not being allowed to retrieve my vehicle until Monday, with a \$60 fee added on. Abyss towing is not open on Sundays, so retrieving my car on a Monday should, at maximum, incur only \$30 additional in storage fees.

3) In my interpretation of the law, though I admit my understanding may be limited, I believe Milwaukee City Ordinance Chapter 93-47, section 4i was violated during this transaction. It states that a business performing a non-consensual tow cannot "Refuse payment for towing services by cash or by debit, credit or charge card. Abyss Towing refused to accept any payment other than cash.

4) I believe Abyss Towing has violated Milwaukee City Ordinance 93-47, section 6 in that no schedule of fees according to s. Trans 319.03 Wis. Admin. Code is posted in a visible location at their place of business- at least that I could see- as is required. Perhaps, they are available in a separate location, but on that day, there were no visible signs on the fence surrounding the lot, which is all I had access to. It concerns me that this is not posted, as others may not have ready access and means to look up either Administrative Code or City Ordinances, and thus may be taken advantage of.

In all, I believe that I was treated unfairly, and perhaps illegally by this place of business. It is my hope that reporting this incident will bring these business practices to light and prevent them from happening to any other individual involved in a non-consensual tow with Abyss Towing. 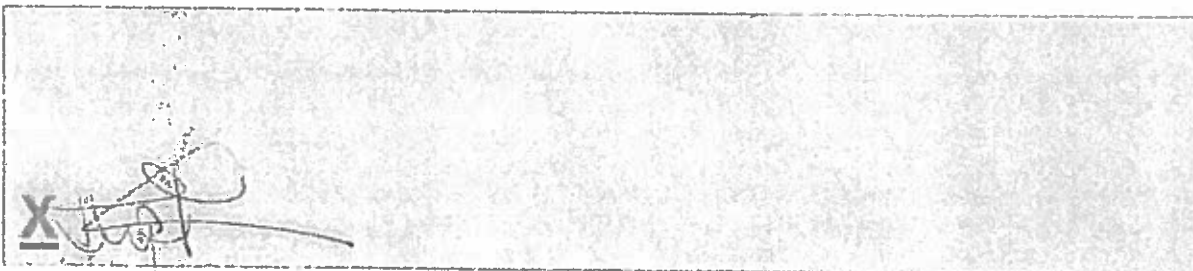
