
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Curtis Ward, a City of Milwaukee D.P.W. employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City vehicle that was traveling westbound on West North Avenue. As the City vehicle proceeded through the intersection of West North Avenue and North 7th Street, Daniel Rogers, who was insured by Progressive Insurance Company, rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. Shortly thereafter, the uninsured motorist (hit-and-run driver) rear-ended the Rogers vehicle, which caused a second impact with the City vehicle. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Ward sustained injuries to his neck, back, and left leg. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$29,260.02.
