Accused Member: Internal Affairs Supervisor Lt. Richards, Investigator Dt. Michael Chaperon, P.O.s: Brian Brosseau #65688, Michael Meade #63610, Alex Ramirez #58415, Ray L. Walker #59093, Henry Zimmerman, Pinter-squad 78RE, and backup officers 7PL, 287PL, and ETC.

I was arrested for fleeing and obstructing on the above date and time and location by most of the above mentioned Police Officers. At the scene I was pepper sprayed, and searched. Approximately \$938.00 dollars, and a 18k whitegold ringband was taken off my person and never returned when I was booked in the Milw.Co. jail only but \$55.00 dollars turned over. My bills consisted of (8) \$100.00 dollar bills, and the rest was broken up in \$20.00s, \$10.00s, \$5.00s, and \$1.00s. My 18k whitegold ringband was a plain thick whitegold band. I was given my money previously my arrest from my fiancée Loretta Butt which was part of her 2001 income tax re-turns as Dt. Michael Chaperon investigation will clearly indicate, and ignored. And Supervisor Lt. Richards mockingly laughed it off over the telephone to my and Ms. Butt's face as we complained about the incident.

Damages Sought: For the way of this conievingly confiscation of my \$938.00 dollars and my 18k whitegold ringband, I Wallace Burks am seeking monetarily damages for \$1,083.00 cash, with a deppreciation value for \$200.00 dollars on my ring, and less the \$55.00 that was booked in the Milw. Co. jail.
