There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

We have had the opportunity to speak with your office previously, and while there have been no major issues, a concern has arisen regarding a recent change of license for the bar next door. We were not notified by your office of this transaction, and we learned of it through a third party.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 05/25/2019 at 2:05am officers conducted a licensed premise check at Woody's Bar, 1579 S 2nd St. The officers observed 10 patrons at the bar with open beer bottles. The bartender then advised the patrons it was closing time. The bartender presented his license and stated he does not normally work on Thursday nights and lost track of the time. The bartender was cooperative and no other violations were observed.
2. On 05/25/2019 at 10:47pm officers were dispatched to a battery at Woody's, 1579 S 2nd St. The victim stated he was battered by patrons of Woody's bar outside on the sidewalk. The applicant stated he did not have a camera in the location the incident occurred but assisted the officers in viewing the available video. The video contradicted the victim, who then stated it was a passerby that struck him.
3. On 06/20/2019 a meeting was held at District 2 regarding the after-hours incident at Woody's on 05/25/2019. The applicant was advised to start closing the business 30 minutes early to allow time for the patrons to leave. He was also advised how to amend his hours of operation. The applicant advised that he was going to upgrade the camera system and exterior lighting.

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4. On 12/01/23 at 1:23a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight at 1579 S. 2nd St. Investigation revealed two intoxicated patrons were escorted out and were trying to regain entry. There was no fight and the business was cooperative.
5. On 01/19/24 at 11:00p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 1579 S, 2nd St. The caller stated people are often observed smoking and drinking outside of the business. On arrival officers did not find any violations and the business was cooperative.
6. On 03/08/24 at 12:50a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery-DV at 1579 S. 2nd St. The officers were met by the caller who stated a physical altercation occurred outside of the bar. The officers stated two patrons were arguing upon entrance, however, left and no physical altercation occurred. The business was cooperative.

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7. On 10/16/25 at 3:12p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Entry. Investigation revealed a subject pried a door open, however, was met by an employee. The suspect left upon request of the employee. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
8. On 11/01/25 at 9:26p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Welfare of Citizen. The business called regarding a disruptive, intoxicated subject. The subject was conveyed home.
9. On 02/12/26 at 9:20p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject. The business called regarding a subject causing a disturbance. The subject requested medical assistance and was conveyed to a local hospital.
10. On 02/26/26 at 8:43p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject. The business called regarding a subject causing a disturbance. On arrival the subject was no longer on scene.
11. On 03/05/26 at 10:41p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject. The caller stated subjects were outside smoking marijuana. On arrival the officer did not observe any subjects outside, and the bartender stated they will advise patrons of the complaint and advise them not to smoke marijuana outside of the business.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


