Dear Alderman Witkowski:

During field observations at the easterly driveway at the Howard Johnson's Hotel, our Traffic Engineering staff found that motorists existing the driveway still have a difficult time seeing westbound motorists on West Layton Avenue even with the present 40 feet of "No Parking" for sight clearance. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing an additional 20 feet of "No Parking" to increase sight visibility at the driveway.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting so that you may support it to final passage.
