This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$917.62, relating to damage sustained to your vehicle on May 29, 2002 when you allegedly ran over an open manhole in the 3900 block of North 35th Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division records indicate that the incident was not reported to them, and they had no notification prior to your claim. They subsequently conducted a field investigation and found the City's manhole covers in good condition. Since there is no evidence that the City was responsible for this loss, it cannot be held liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.
