There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

My name is _____ and I am writing to formally object to the issuance of a liquor license and entertainment license for this proposed business. The surrounding neighborhood is already saturated with establishments that serve alcohol, and residents continue to experience concerns related to alcohol-related activity, public disturbances, illegal drug activity, and prostitution in the area. Adding another venue that serves alcohol and provides entertainment has the potential to increase foot traffic, late-night activity, noise, and other issues that negatively impact the safety and quality of life of those who live nearby. Many residents have worked hard to maintain a stable community environment, and there is significant concern that another licensed establishment could

worsen existing problems rather than improve the neighborhood.

In addition to public safety concerns, parking in this area is already extremely limited for residents and visitors. The nearby streets are often congested, and the proposed location appears to have very few dedicated parking spaces available to accommodate customers. Increased traffic and parking demand would place an additional burden on surrounding homes and businesses. As a parent of two young teenagers, I am especially concerned about the long-term effects that increased exposure to alcohol-related activity, drug problems, and other criminal behavior could have on families in the neighborhood. Residents deserve a safe and secure environment, and for these reasons I respectfully request that the liquor and entertainment license application be denied.

The City of Milwaukee is subject to Wisconsin Statutes related to public records. Unless otherwise exempted from the public records law, senders and receivers of City of Milwaukee e-mail should presume that e-mail is subject to release upon request, and is subject to state records retention requirements.

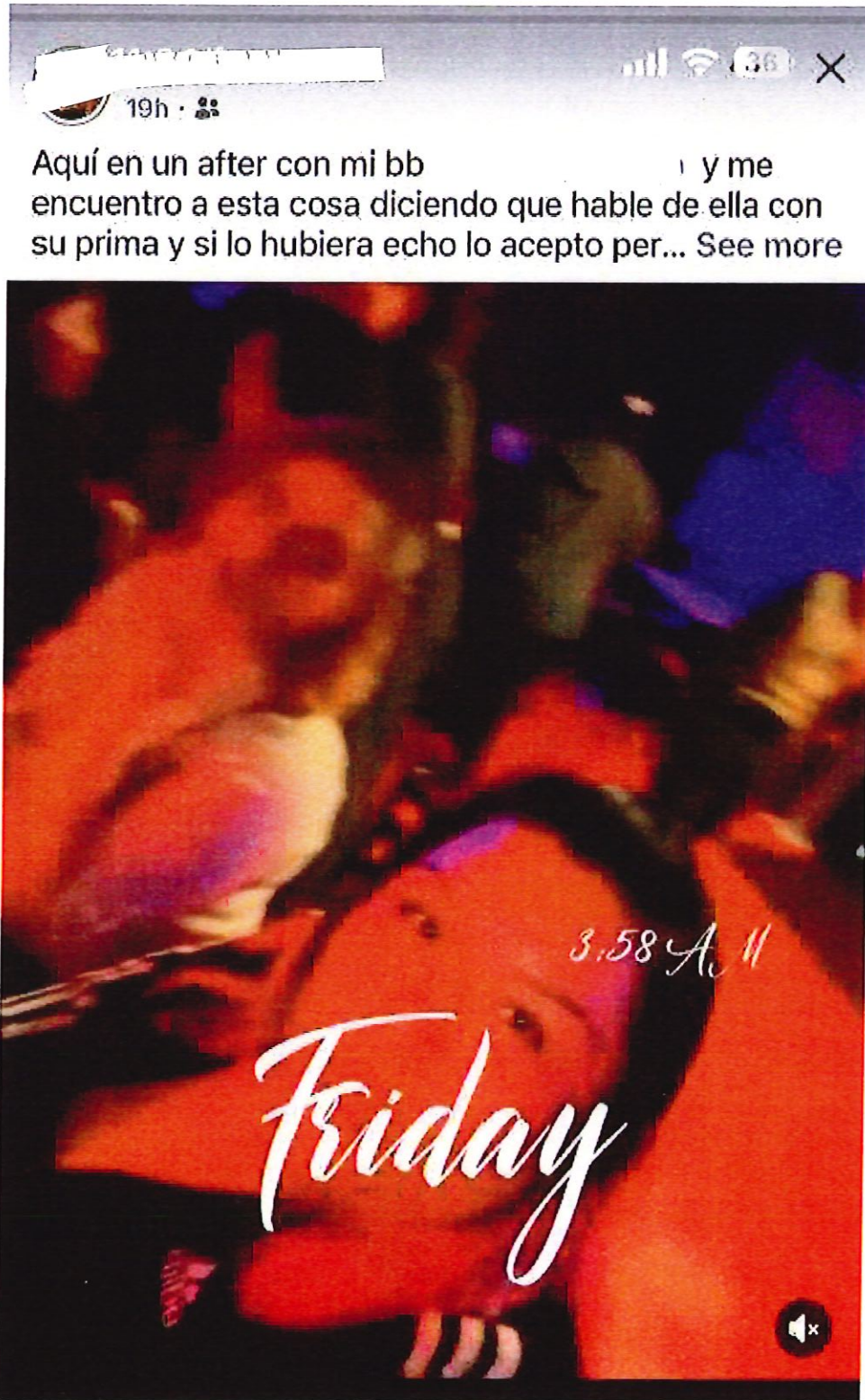

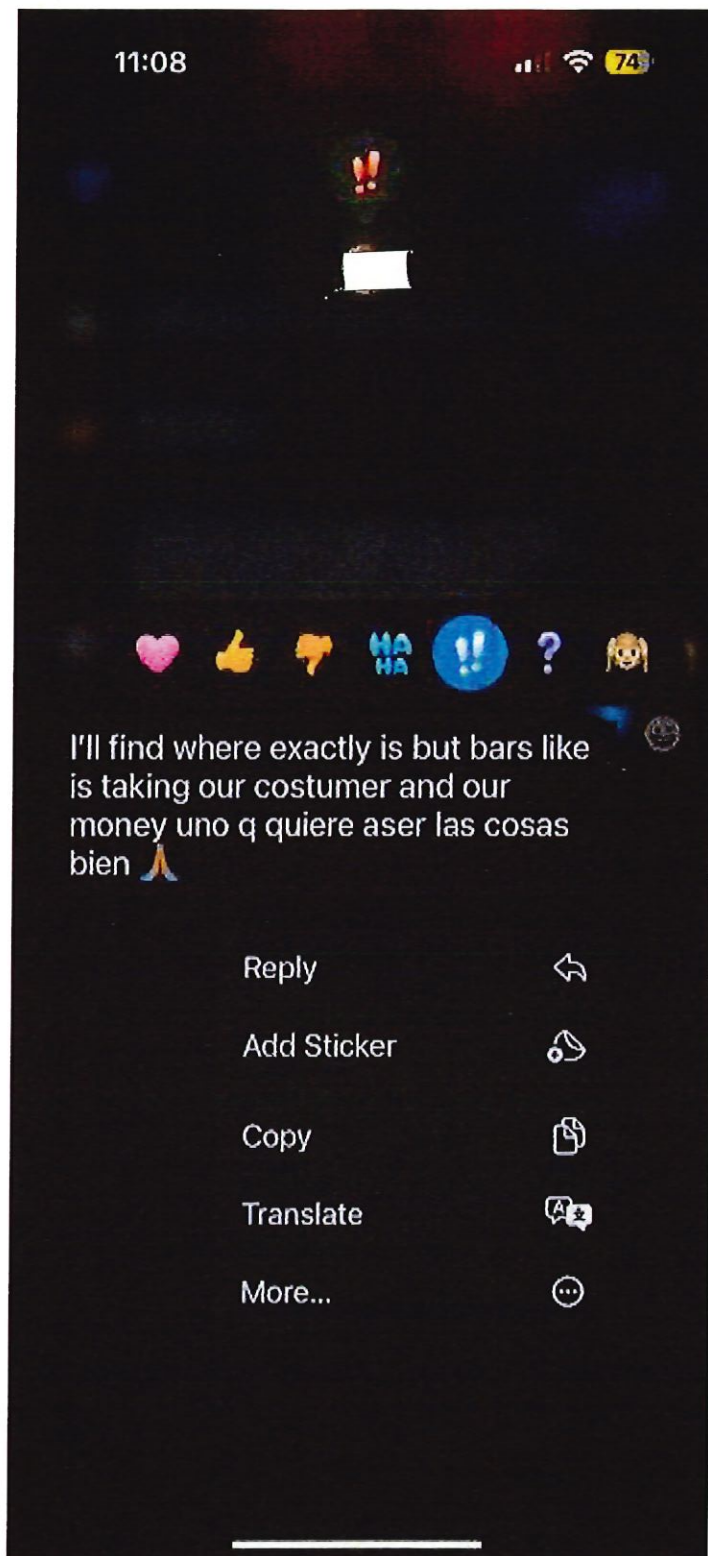

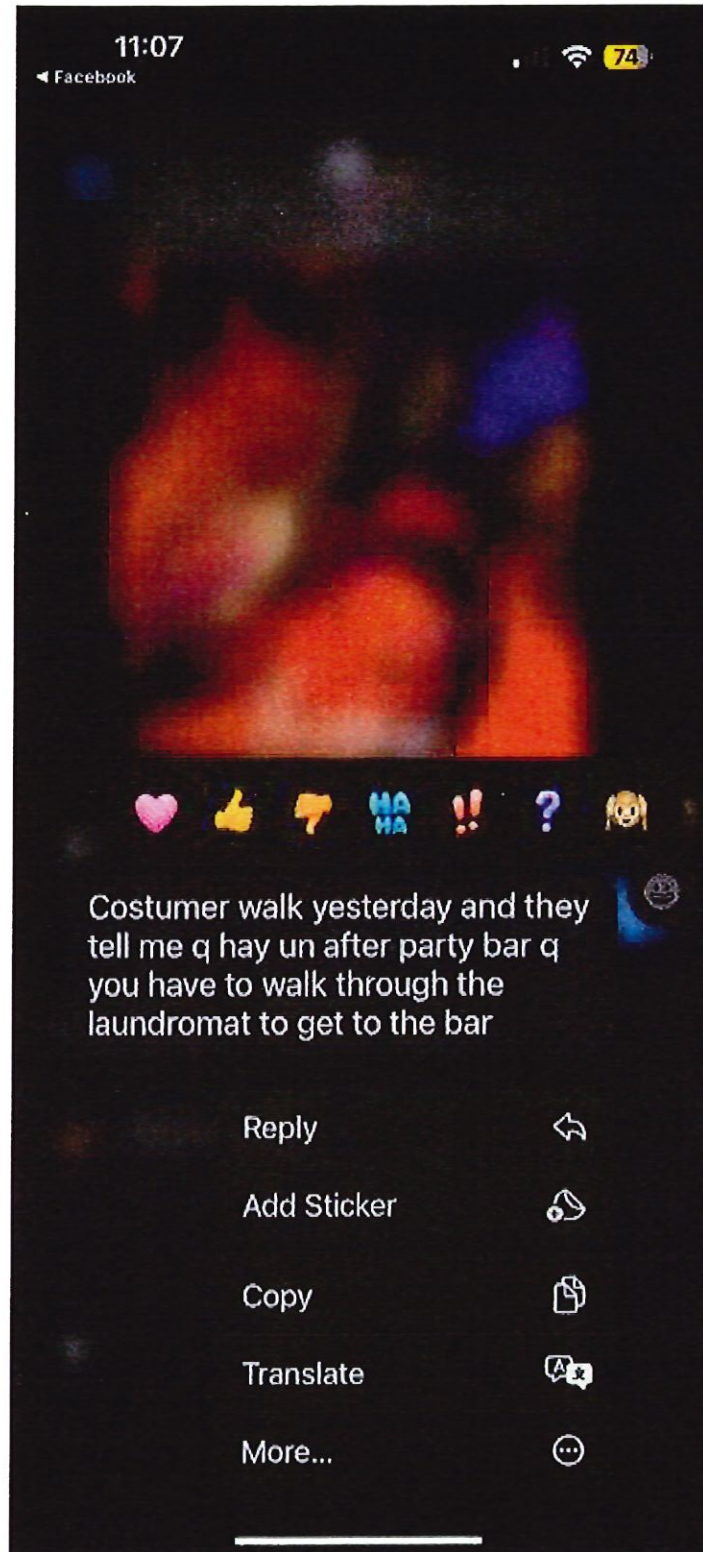

RE: Notice of Chronic After Set Premises Designation

Dear Inderjeet DHILLON:

This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Chief of Police, by the chief's designee, the district commander, has designated the premises located at 551 W Becher St Milwaukee, WI 53207 ("the premises") as a chronic after set premises pursuant to Milwaukee Code of Ordinances 80-11-5, After Sets.

This designation is based upon you having been billed for the costs of police services and enforcement relating to after set activities occurring at the premises for three or more separate occurrences of after set activities within a one-year time period. The following is a concise description of after set activities that have occurred at the premises, the dates on which they occurred, the amount billed for the cost of enforcement, and the relevant sections of the code:

1. On Saturday, April 19, 2025, at or about 3:12 am, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premise for a Call for Police complaint, where the caller stated that she was inside the premise and being held against her will and not allowed to leave the premise because "police were outside". The caller stated that she attended the location for a party, and there was a cover charge at the door to enter. Officers on scene observed loud music and yelling from inside the premise, and prior to being dispatched, officers observed 20-30 people entering the location. The owner of the premise, Inderjeet DHILLON was given a special charge of \$197.95 for the cost of police services. This activity is in violation of c. 108-5 of the code.
2. On Saturday, April 26, 2025, at or about 4:24am, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premise for a Subject with a Weapon complaint, where the caller stated that she was at the premise and a group of men and women were battering her friend, and someone was armed with a gun. Follow up was conducted with one of the parties involved who stated that the incident occurred at the premise, which they thought was a bar. They stated that every patron was charged a \$10 entry fee, there was approximately 100 patrons inside, and there was a subject bartending and charging money for drinks

served. The owner of the premise, Inderjeet DHILLON was given a special charge of \$78.98 for the cost of police services This activity is in violation of c. 90-3 of the code.

3. On Sunday, September 7, 2025, at or about 2:33am, Milwaukee police officers were dispatched to the premise for a Shooting complaint, where the caller stated that "Subjects with guns were fighting at the location, and a subject is shooting". Police responded to the location and entered the premise. Once inside, officers observed buckets of beer on all the tables, and two subjects behind the premises' bar serving drinks, which was lined with bottles of liquor. Officers spoke with the subject who rents the location, who stated that he wasn't selling alcohol, but he was rather "giving it away", and the event was a "private party for friends and family". The premise does not have a current PEP or liquor license through the City of Milwaukee. Officers performed a head count of the subjects inside and counted 129 persons. The owner of the premise, Inderjeet DHILLON was given a special charge of \$419.23 for the cost of police services This activity is in violation of c. 90-3 of the code.

Each subsequent occurrence of after set activity at the premises for a period of two years from the date of this notice may be deemed a separate violation and shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 for failure to abate the after set activity. Upon default of payment of a chronic after set citation you would be subject to imprisonment as provided by law.

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/16/25 at 8:30a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired at 555 W. Becher St. Investigation revealed this was a DV situation, that escalated when the victim ran into the business at 551 W. Becher, at which time the suspect fired rounds into the business. One of the victims was identified as the applicant who stated they are currently renting both the laundromat and adjoining bar/restaurant. The officers did find alcohol behind the bar, however, there was no license for the establishment. The victim/applicant stated they were in the process of obtaining permits, however, a check of License Information Reporting Administration revealed no licenses were approved.
2. On 04/27/25 at 3:00a.m., a Police Officer responded to monitor the area of 551 W. Becher due to chronic after-set activity. The officer observed subjects exiting the laundromat and subjects attempting to gain entry. The officer noted in prior encounters the exterior lights were illuminated, however, they had now been turned off. The officer noted on a prior occasion, they were granted access by the key holder, identified as the applicant.
3. On 09/07/25 at 2:33a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 551 W. Becher St. On arrival officers observed approximately 100 people attempting to flee out windows and a side door. Upon entrance officers observed employees behind the bar, alcoholic beverages that were being sold as well as buckets of beer on the majority of tables in the business. The applicant was on scene and stated they were in charge of the

gathering and was under the assumption as long as they weren't charging money for entry or drinks they could have people at the location. Two officers obtained capacity numbers of 128 and 129. The applicant was issued a citation for Illegal Alcohol Distribution Unlicensed Premise **Case #25024679** Arraignment is scheduled for 11/10/25 8:30a.m.

4. On 09/13/25 at 3:35a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired at 551 W. Becher St. Prior to arrival the CAD stated there was a shooting and a woman was being held in the basement and they were refusing to let her leave. On arrival all the windows were blocked with thick black sheets. Due to exigent circumstances officers made entry into the adjacent laundry mat and advised to subjects that were hiding to leave. The officers then made entry into the attached bar, at which time approximately 50 patrons were observed who yelled "Happy Birthday". Patrons were observed with alcoholic beverages, as well as a fully stocked bar. The applicant was on scene and argumentative, stating there was no one trapped in the basement and the people were there for a birthday party. As officers were escorting patrons out, one patron asked if they could finish their alcoholic beverage as they were "charged way too much for it". The applicant was issued **Citation #25027351** for Distribute Alcohol at Unlicensed Premise with a future court date of 11/24/25 at 1:30p.m. (2 reports)
5. On 09/21/25 at 2:23a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 551 W. Becher St. Shortly after knocking on the door, the applicant came outside and stated they were not serving alcohol and were hosting a private party. The applicant was advised they were not allowed to host private parties, and all subjects had to leave. The officers remained outside and counted 82 subjects leave the premise.
6. On 09/30/25 at 2:00p.m., Milwaukee Police held a meeting with the applicant regarding the after-set activity. Items discussed were after-set activities, nuisance designation letters and billings to the building owner related to chronic nuisance activity. The applicant stated they ceased all activities at the location and are only conducting repairs and renovations. The applicant and building owner were both reminded any future unlicensed activity will result in further citation and/or arrests.
7. On 10/12/25 at 2:54a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an Overdose, later determined to be a Trouble with Subject. On arrival officers observed the parking lot filled with patrons leaving the laundromat side of the business. As more people exited the door to the bar side opened while approximately 50 people fled out of the business. Officers made entrance and observed the applicant, holding a black hand-held radio, walking around the bar area. Officers observed numerous beer and liquor bottles on the tables, behind the counter and in the basement, as well as plastic single use straws. Officers also located green plant like material, suspected of marijuana on the floor, and a ledger containing sales data. The applicant was arrested and issued citations for Single Use Straws Prohibited and Responsible Person on Premise. **Citations 0681PNLHMH / 0681PNLHMG**

8. On 01/30/26 at 3:15a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject. The windows had blackout curtains; therefore, officers were unable to see inside the business, however, there did not appear to be anyone in distress. The officers remained on scene for approximately 15 minutes for observation due to past instances of after sets, however, no one exited the location.

9. On 02/01/26 at 2:21a.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a business check on a possible illegal after-set, however, there was no answer at the door. The officers monitored the business for over an hour and did not observe anyone coming or going.

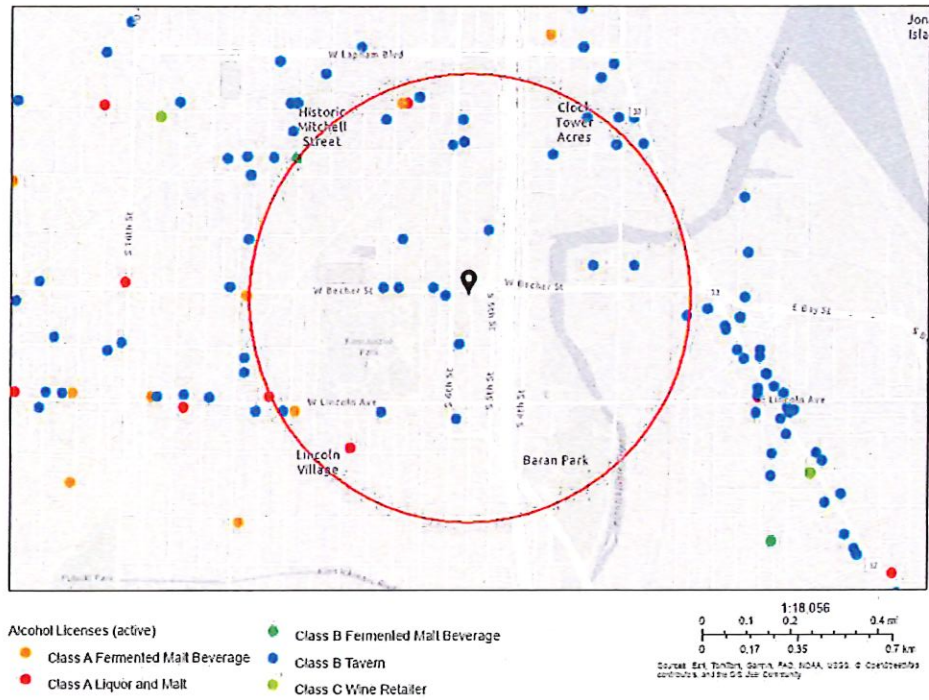


City Concentration Map 551 W. BECHER STREET
