
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Brad Bratel, a DPW employee, was operating a City vehicle in the course of employment and traveling southbound on North Hopkins Street. The uninsured motorist was being pursued by a fully marked police vehicle with its emergency lights and siren activated and traveling northbound on North Hopkins Street in a stolen vehicle. The uninsured motorist disregarded the red traffic signal at the intersection with West Hampton Avenue and crossed the center line into the southbound lanes of North Hopkins Street, striking the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Mr. Bratel sustained injuries to his chest, head and back. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$74,754.43.
