In addition to any permanent taxicab meter rate increase, the following temporary taxicab fare surcharges and meter rate increases were established or extended between July 4, 2000, and March 26, 2007, in order to offset the increased fuel costs paid by taxicab owners and operators:

1. A temporary taxicab fare surcharge of $\$ 1$ was established on each ride for a period of 90 days from July 4, 2000, through October 3, 2000.
2. A temporary $\$ 1$ surcharge was established on each ride for a period of 120 days from July 1, 2005, through October 27, 2005. Prior to expiration, the temporary fare surcharge was extended by an additional 60 days, expiring after December 27, 2005.
3. A temporary $\$ 1$ taxicab meter rate increase was established for a period of 180 days from May 26, 2006, through November 26, 2006, and increased the meter rate from $\$ 1.75$ to $\$ 2.75$ for the first $1 / 8$ th of a mile. Prior to expiration, the temporary meter rate increase was extended by an additional 110 days, expiring on March 16, 2007, when a permanent $\$ 0.50$ meter rate increase became effective for the first $1 / 8$ th of a mile.

No temporary taxicab fare surcharge or meter rate increase is currently in effect.
