RE: Resolution relating to the historic designation for the George Knowles, Jr. House at 1879 N. Cambridge Avenue, in the 3rd Aldermanic District.

An application was recently submitted to the Historic Preservation Commission to designate the George Knowles, Jr. House at 1879 N. Cambridge Avenue as a historic site or structure (see map on back of this page).

A public hearing has been scheduled for Monday, January 14, 2013 at 3:00 p.m. in City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Room 301-B to determine whether or not the proposed designation of the George Knowles, Jr. House at 1879 N. Cambridge Avenue satisfies the criteria for historic designation in accordance with Section 320-21 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

If the Commission determines the building meets at least one criterion, a favorable recommendation for nomination can be forwarded to the Milwaukee Common Council.
