**RE:** Proactive Spotter Deployment – Possible Youth Take-Over Events – Friday, April 3, 2026

## Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to advise the Milwaukee Police Department and HACM leadership of a proactive operational deployment plan by the Housing Authority of the City of Milwaukee (HACM) Public Safety Department regarding possible youth take-over events that may occur on Friday, April 3, 2026, between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. at various HACM developments.

## Deployment Locations and District Alignment

HACM Public Safety has received information regarding possible gatherings that may occur on Friday, April 3, 2026, between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. HACM Public Safety will be proactively monitoring the following developments. The corresponding Milwaukee Police Department districts are as follows:

This district alignment is provided to ensure proper communication and coordination with the appropriate Milwaukee Police Department district should conditions arise that require law enforcement notification or response.

## Operational Plan

HACM Public Safety will implement proactive monitoring and roving operations as follows:

### Proactive Monitoring Assignments:

HACM Public Safety Specialists and Supervisors will be assigned to each of the above-listed developments to monitor activity in real time and observe for large crowd gatherings, disturbances, traffic disruptions, reckless activity, or other behavior that may impact resident safety and quality of life.

## **Roving Patrol Units:**

HACM Public Safety Specialists and HACM Public Safety Supervisors will conduct roving patrols at each of the identified developments from **12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.** on Friday, April 3, 2026. Units will monitor for large groups forming, traffic disruptions, reckless activity, or other disturbances impacting resident safety and quality of life.

## **Supervisor Notification Protocol:**

HACM Public Safety Supervisors will notify HACM Public Safety Leadership, if large crowds begin to gather at any HACM development. Leadership will assess the situation and determine whether the circumstances justify notification to the Milwaukee Police Department.

## **Law Enforcement Coordination and Notification**

If conditions arise requiring law enforcement response or support, HACM Public Safety Senior Leadership will notify the appropriate Milwaukee Police Department District Lieutenant's Office and provide the following information:

- Location of gathering
- Development name
- Estimated crowd size
- Nature of activity observed
