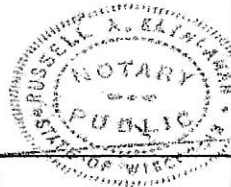

Establishment of the boundary of Neighborhood Improvement District No. 6 (Historic Garden Homes) and approval of its Initial Operating Plan for the area generally bounded by West Hampton Avenue at North 27th Street proceeding east on the south side of West Hampton Avenue to North Teutonia Avenue; proceeding south on the west side of North Teutonia Avenue to West Roosevelt Drive; proceeding east on the north side of West Roosevelt Drive to North 27th Street; and proceeding north on the east side of North 27th Street to end at West Hampton Avenue.
