While some improvements have been made, I have been heavily disappointed by the removal of the recommendation to make duplexes and triplexes legal city-wide. I am also suspicious of the overlay zones; I think there is a great potential for misuse by wealthier neighborhoods that could result in displacement and the exodus of Milwaukee's young middle class to less wealthy neighborhoods causing further displacement. > Nonetheless, though imperfect, I support this plan. It is a step in the right direction that can help address our previous mistakes and move the city in a better direction. It supports higher densities which can provide a number of benefits, chief among them: > - Lower, more predicable increases in rent for renters > - Higher quality of units as landlords are forced to compete for tenants > - The creation of a greater variety of types of housing that are more suitable to an individual or family's needs > - Higher property tax-per-acre for the city > - Lower costs to deliver services per person > - The creation of a larger population to support local businesses > - The shortening of commute times as people can live closer to job centers > - A more supportive environment for public transit and biking which can save people money and give people options > This is a compromise bill and it's clear that not everyone gets what they want.
