
REASON FOR REQUEST:

Darrell Walker, a City of Milwaukee DPW employee, was in the scope of his employment and operating a city vehicle that was traveling westbound on West Lincoln Avenue. As the city vehicle entered the intersection of West Lincoln Avenue and South Layton Boulevard, the uninsured motorist, who was traveling southbound on South Layton Boulevard, failed to yield the right of way by disregarding the red traffic light causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

The claimant sustained injuries to his right shoulder, right elbow, right leg and chest. The treating physician indicated the right shoulder injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$116,433.16.
