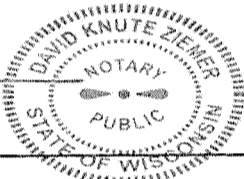

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the April 21, 2015 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:
Resolution approving the Menomonee Valley Area Comprehensive Plan Update as an element of Milwaukee's Overall Comprehensive Plan, in the 4th, 8th and 12th Aldermanic Districts.
Whereas, One step in the City of Milwaukee's ("City") comprehensive planning process is the creation of plans for areas of the City, sometimes referred to as neighborhoods; and
Whereas, An updated comprehensive plan has been prepared, titled the Menomonee Valley Area Comprehensive Plan Update ("Plan"), a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File; and
Whereas, The Plan amends and updates the Market Study, Engineering and Land Use Plan for the Menomonee Valley that was approved by the Common Council on September 23, 1998, by File No. 980698; and
Whereas, Pursuant to Section 66.1001, Wisconsin Statutes, the City Plan Commission adopted the Plan and recommended adoption to the Common Council; and
Whereas, Approval of the Plan by the Common Council will establish the Plan as a guide for the City regarding the use and development of the land of the area, it will encourage common understanding and coordination among levels of government and private interests and it will facilitate implementation of the Plan; now, therefore, be it
Resolved, That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, approves the Menomonee Valley Area Comprehensive Plan Update as an element of the City's Overall Comprehensive Plan; and, be it
Further Resolved, That the Menomonee Valley Area Comprehensive Plan Update, as approved, shall provide guidance and serve as the basis for decision-making by the Common Council in its consideration of land use and physical development issues; and, be it
Further Resolved, That the Department of City Development ("DCD"), the Department of Neighborhood Services, the Department of Public Works and other City departments and agencies are directed to work toward implementation of the Plan; and, be it
Further Resolved, That the Commissioner of DCD is directed to send copies of the Plan to the parties identified in it as having responsibility for implementation of the Plan for their reference and use.
Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Thursday, May 28, 2015 at 9:00 A.M., pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.
The Plan Update will be available for viewing in the subject Common Council File and on the website <http://www.planthevalley.org/> on or before April 28, 2015. Written comments should be submitted no later than May 21, 2015.

Therefore, notice is given that this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Common Council or any of its Standing Committees, and must be noticed as such, although they will not take any formal action at this meeting.
