
This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$228.41, relating to damage sustained to your vehicle on May 3, 2004 where you allege it was hit with a piece of cardboard that bounced off a City garbage truck that was on southbound I-34 south of the Stadium Interchange.

Our investigation reveals that the Fleet Accident Report completed as a result of this alleged incident notes that the driver of the City truck indicated that he does not use this route. Therefore, in the absence of proof to the contrary, we must take credence in the testimony of the truck driver and not accept liability. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.


Mr Grant Langlely and Mr Steven Carini-

I do wish to appeal this decision! Your letter states that I allege that this happened on I-34. I did not make up the truck numbers. My wife was driving the car, so I had the opportunity to get a good look at the truck numbers.

The city is responsible for the damage to my antennae and the roof scratch. I am only asking for the antennae repair. Should I ask for roof repair also? I do not get much reception without the antennae, and it has already been over four months since this happened.

On May 3, 04 7:15 AM I was traveling south on I341 just south of the stadium interchange. I was behind a city truck with a dumpster full of tree branches. The load was covered, but there were several pieces of cardboard pushed in behind the branches and behind the end of the cover. A large piece of cardboard bounced out of the truck, landed on the roof of my car putting a scratch in the material and then it hit the antennae and bent it over. It is an electric antennae that moves up and down, which it can not do now. I have enclosed two itemized estimates for the repair for it. The dumpster was number 20-340 and was on a Peterbuilt truck with number 31149 on the door and number 4171 on a card inside the windshield. The truck was southbound and turned in to the city property at 41 st and Lincoln Ave. I work at Hennes Services 4100 W. Lincoln Ave. My phone number is 672-3470.

I would appreciate it very much if the city would pay for this repair work.

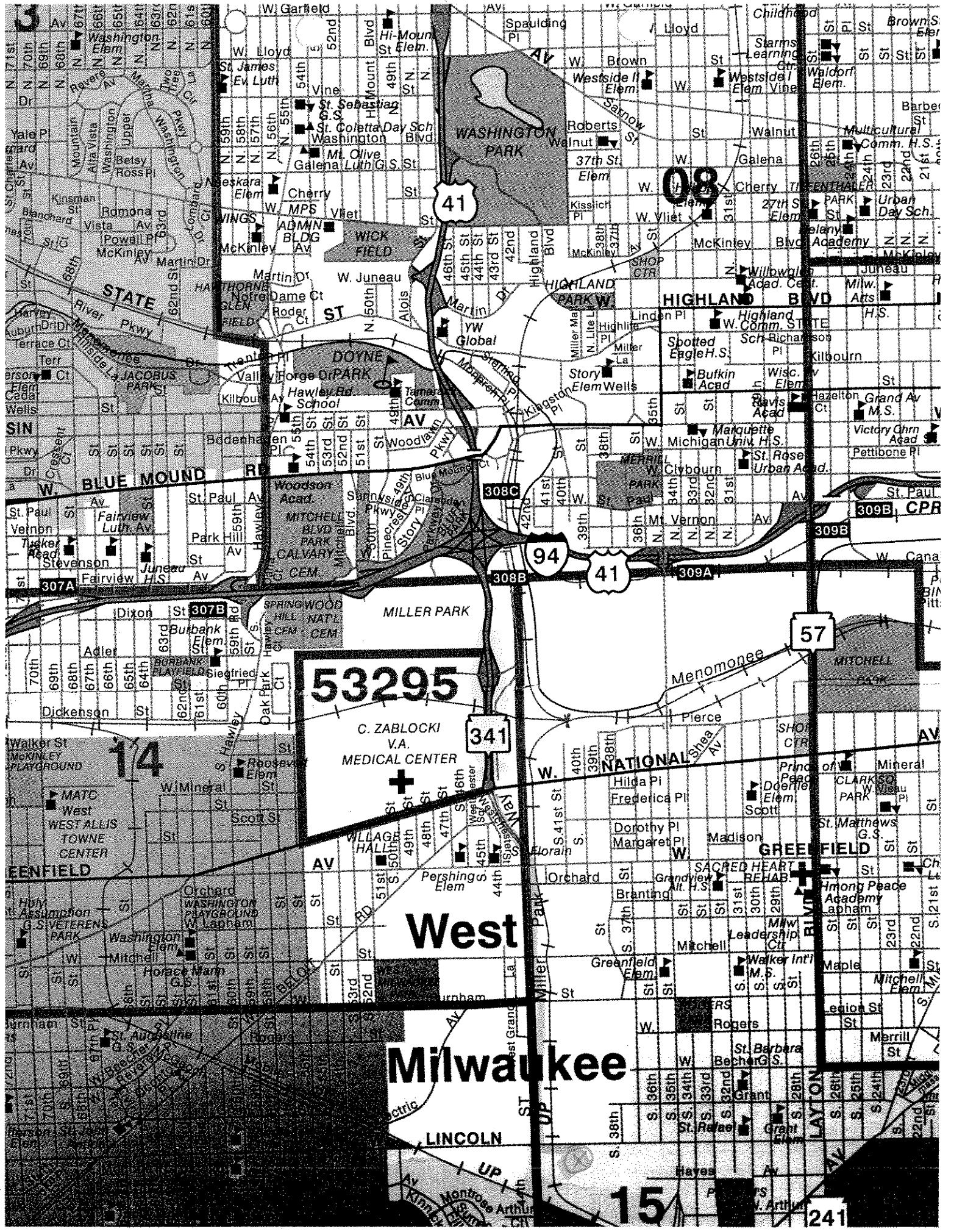
