I wanted to keep you posted regarding the Clarion Hotel located at 6331 S. 13th St...

We have received complaints from regarding the trash build up at the location. The day of our Hotel /Motel meeting is when we first observed the issue at hand. We contacted DNS and an issue was order for clean up on 2-16-2022 and again on 3-16-2022.

We spoke to the front desk (3-24-2022) and was advised the owner was out of the country. It seemed their plan of attack was to just let the City conduct their clean ups. I advised the front desk that was an unacceptable practice and it is their responsibility as a business. We left our contact info for the owner and have not received a call back regarding.

The latest order gave the Clarion until 3-30-2022 to clean up the garbage and have additional garbage containers.

As of today we were advised the original trash bins have been removed. This may be due to the late payments to their original contractor.

has stated now the garbage is just scattered in the back corner of the property.

I am reaching out to the DNS inspector who issued the latest order and will be advising him of the latest updates. I have also sent Choice Hotel an email regarding the issues at the location.



Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- The license Applications is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license Applications are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license Applications.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license Applications.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.






