Section 320-47, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, establishes the City of Milwaukee Sister Cities Committee. The Committee is in the process of establishing guidelines and procedures for the creation of formal sister city relationships in accordance with the standards of SSI.

Attached is a sample form provided by SSI as well as an example of one executed agreement. Such an agreement would have to be adopted by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor prior to execution.


