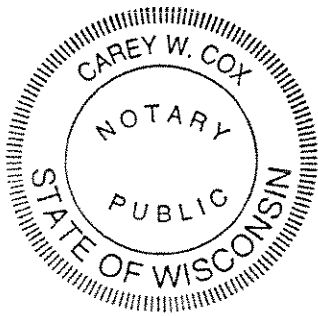

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance (passage of which is now pending) was introduced at the July 7, 2004 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Substitute ordinance creating the Bay View/Wentworth Avenue Interim Study Overlay Zone, generally located along South Shore Drive between East Russell Avenue and East Estes Street, in the 14th Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, do ordain as follows:

Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-1005.0002. The zoning map is amended to establish the Interim Study Overlay Zone (IS) for the area bounded by the zoning line within the right-of-way along East Russell Avenue, a line 96 feet West and parallel to the west line of South Wentworth Avenue, a line 100 feet South and parallel to the south line of East Russell Avenue, a line 150 feet West and parallel to the west line of South Wentworth Avenue, the zoning line within the right-of-way along East Pryor Avenue, the zoning line within the right-of-way along South Superior Street, a line 100.6 feet North and parallel to the north line of East Pryor Avenue, a line 151.7 feet West and parallel to the west line of South Superior Street, a line 150 feet north and parallel to the north line of East Pryor Avenue, the zoning line within the right-of-way along South Superior Street, a line 200 feet North and parallel to the north line of East Pryor Avenue, a line 50 feet West and parallel to the west line of South Superior Street, a line 300 feet North and parallel to the north line of East Pryor Avenue, the zoning line within the right-of-way along South Superior Street, a line 350 feet North and parallel to the north line of East Pryor Avenue, a line 250 feet South and parallel to the south line of East Russell Avenue, the zoning line within the right-of-way along South Superior Street, a line 150 feet South and parallel to the south line of East Russell

Avenue, a line 50 feet West and parallel to the west line of South Superior Street, a line 100 feet South and parallel to the south line of East Russell Avenue, the centerline of South Superior Street, a line 50 feet South and parallel to the south line of East Russell Avenue, and a line 75 feet West and parallel to the west line of South Superior Street.

Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, September 19, 2006 at 9:00 A.M. pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.

PLEASE NOTE: a) Members of the Common Council, and members of its Standing Committees who are not members of this Committee, may attend this meeting to participate or to gather information. Therefore, notice is given that this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Common Council or any of its Standing Committees, and must be noticed as such, although they will not take any formal action at this meeting.
