RE: MPS Stimulus Borrowing Projects

This memorandum is in response to your request for information regarding MPS use of federal stimulus funds for projects at schools that Superintendent Andrekopoulos recommended be studied for closure. According to a September 26, 2009, Journal Sentinel article, the following 14 schools are being studied for closure:

- Category 1 (consistently low academic performance): Garden Homes K-5, Hopkins K-8, Twenty-seventh St. K-8, Wheatley K-8, Milwaukee Education Center Middle School, Milwaukee African American Immersion High School, Professional Learning Institute High School
- Category 2 (varying academic performance): Auer Avenue K-8, Fletcher K-5, Franklin K-8, Kagel K-5, LaFollette K-8, Thirty-fifth St. K-8, DIAL High School
- Category 3 (improving academic performance): Bruce K-5, Milwaukee Learning Laboratory and Institute High School, WORK Institute High School.
