-  = NEW STOP  = EXISTING YIELD

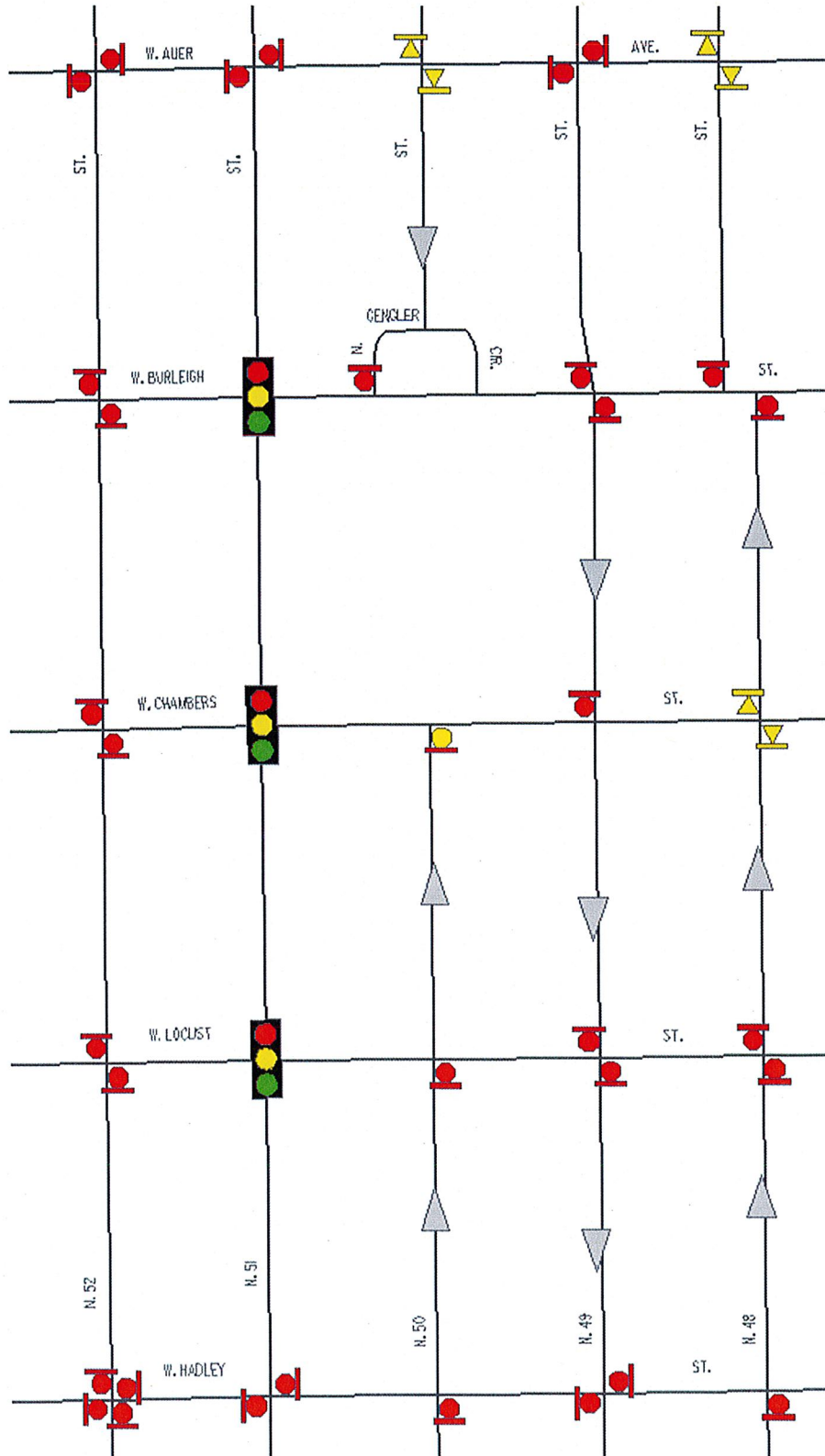



 = NEW STOP

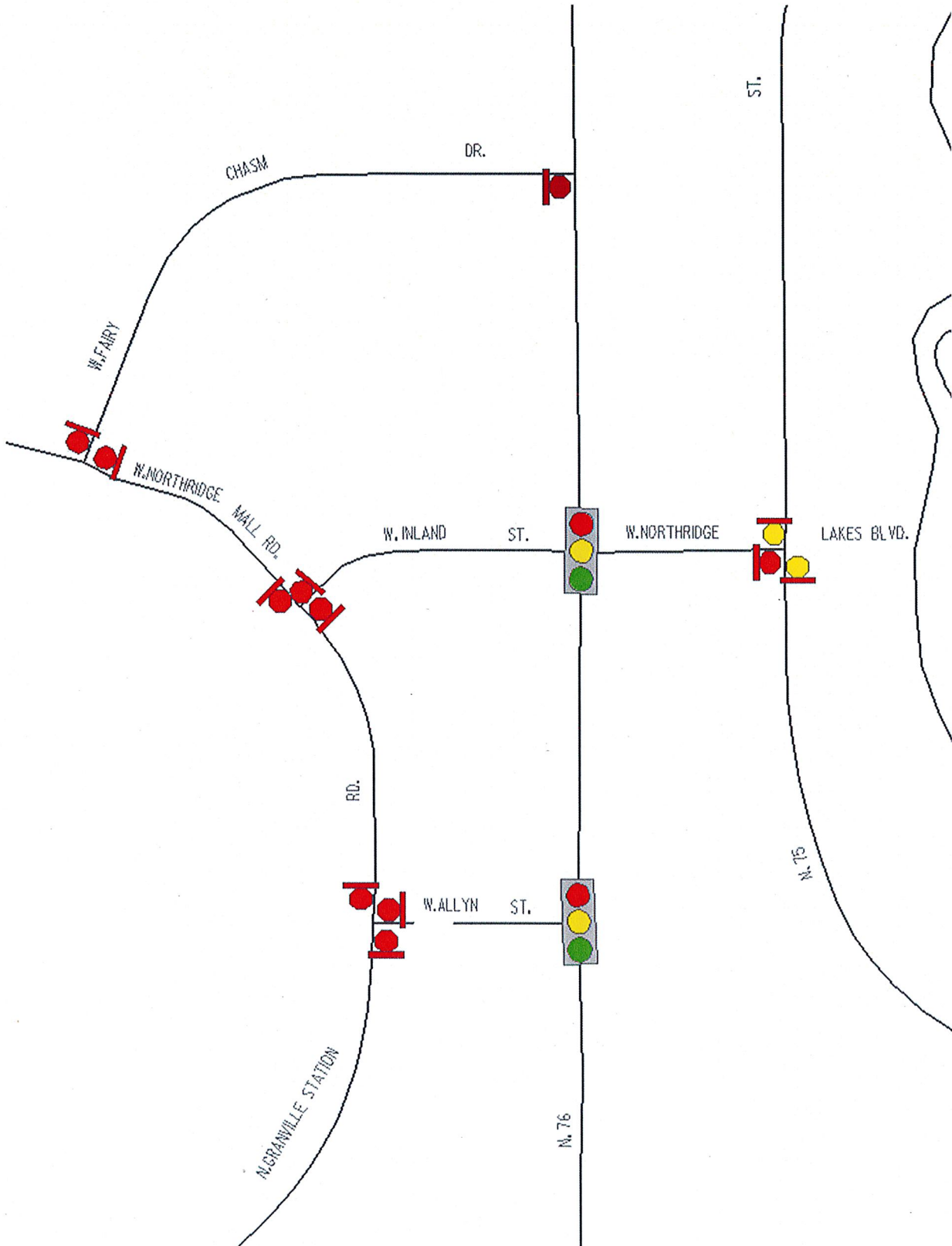
