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I am appealing the reinspection fee imposed on 11/10/2021 for following reasons:

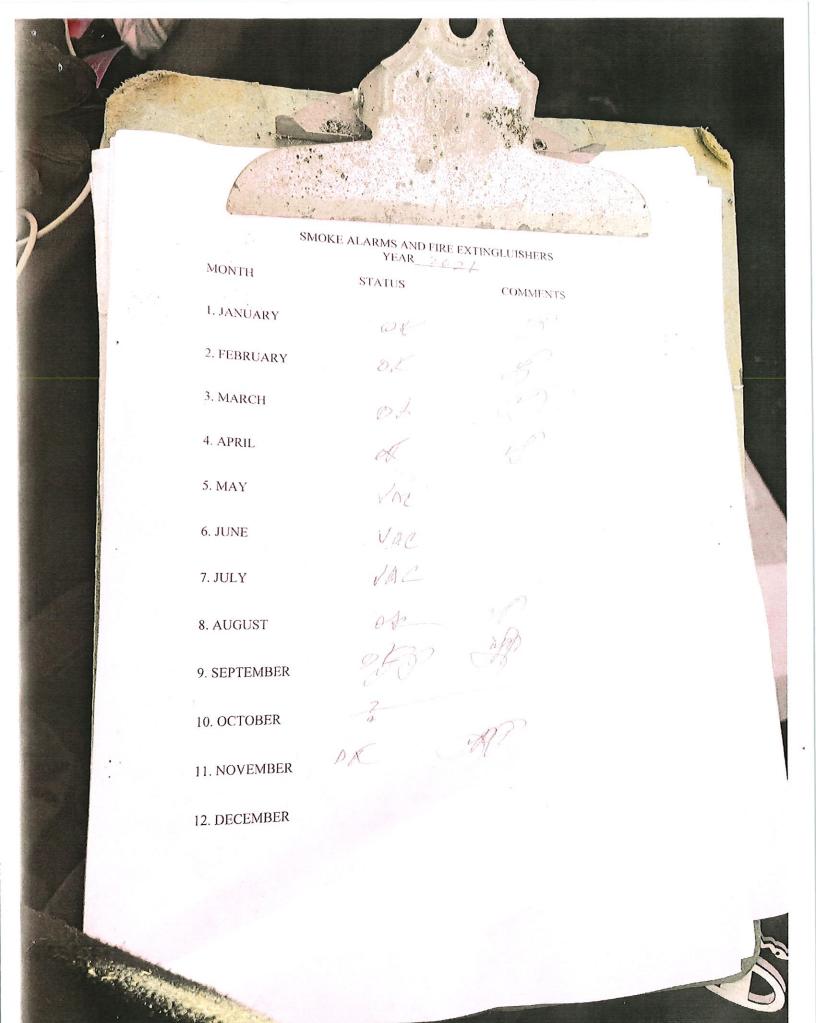
- 1. The property has three floors plus a basement and attic. The second and third floor have been vacant for at least 10 years due to delayed upgrades. The first level has been the only level that has had occupants. However, I have always adhered to Milwaukee Code Ordinances for the commercial property. Every year I allow a fire inspection and make any upgrades required. This year I was ill (surgery and therapy out of town) but had a property manager. Normally, I am notified by mail to arrange for an inspection at mutual agreed time. My first contact with inspector, Nastacia Smith was a week before 11/10/2021. I explained to her I was out of town, A new tenant moved in on 11/1/2021, I had not inspected home for several months but before I left replaced all CO and CO2 detectors with new 10yr detectors and that fire extinguishers were due to be checked when I returned. I return 11/9/2021 and gained access to home on 11/10/21.In fact, inspector Smith was present when I gained access and we inspected the home together.
- 2. Several items were bought to my attention: The CO and CO2 detectors were located in the same location they were at for years of previous inspection. The CO andCO2 detectors were located in each kitchen on every floor. The kitchens has an exit to the common stairway between the levels. Ms Smith informed me that CO detectors are required on all levels of stairway now. I added the additional three detectors in two days. The second item bought to my attention were the fire extinguishers that were due for servicing. I anticipated that and had it done in two days. The third item was a dryer the tenant installed and used flexible venting. I normally install their venting for them but I was out of town. That was taken care of that day. The fourth item was railing I temporarily removed on third floor landing to facilitate moving appliances up to third floor. I am providing all appliances on third floor to avoid having the tenant attempting do it. I will reinstall railings when moves are complete. The fifth item was the inspection log. Due to all the upgrade and repair activity the log was knocked on the floor. I found it the next day. Enclosed is a copy of it.

Hopefully, my action will satisfy your requirements. I only met with inspector once and addressed issues promptly. If there are other concerns please let me know.

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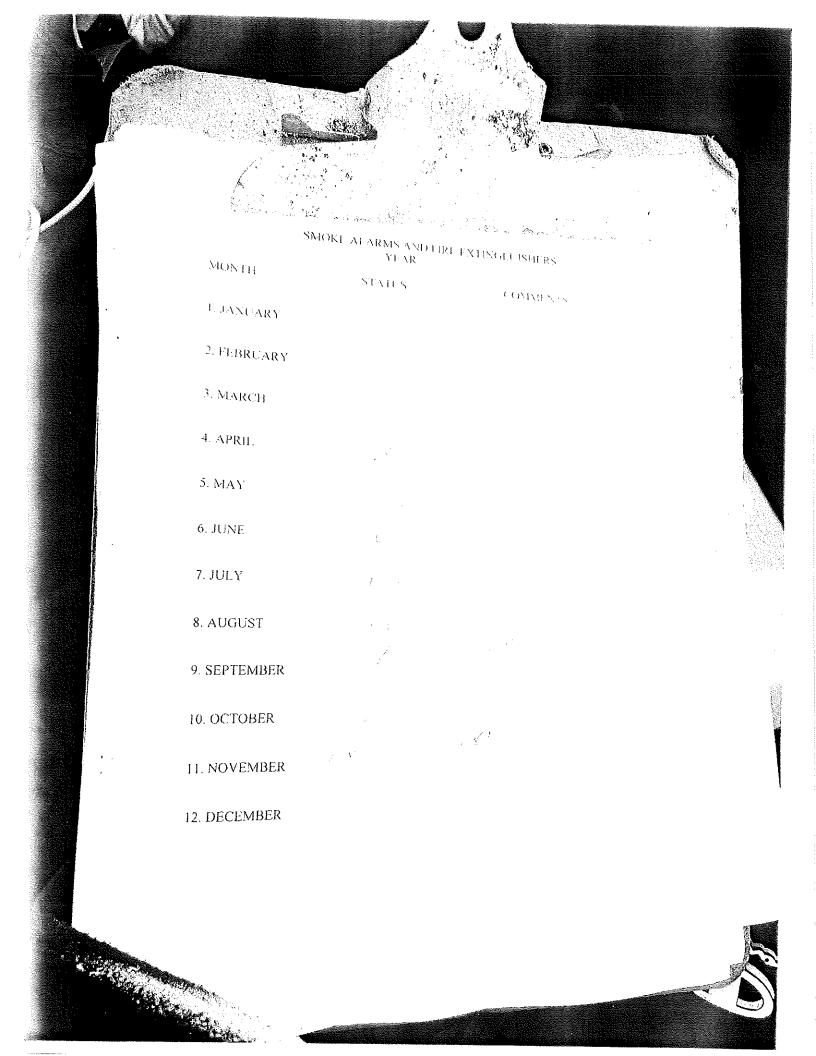
