Dear Mr. Carter:

This is to notify you that on November 27, 2007 the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern and Instrumental Music license for the premises at 2712 North Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Ray's Rhythm & Blues Lounge") be renewed with a 20-day suspension based upon a police report.

On November 29, 2007 you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern and Instrumental Music license in which the Committee recommended that your license be renewed with a twenty (20) day suspension based upon a police report. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of December 11, 2007 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did not appear, nor did you file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council approved the recommendation of the Licenses Committee by a vote of fourteen (14) Ayes and one (1) Excused to approve your license based with a twenty (20) day suspension based upon a police report.

Said suspension is to be in effect between 12:01 a.m. December 13, 2007 through midnight, January 1, 2008.
